About our Traineeship Program:

Applications are now open for our Electrical Design Trainee intake, commencing in January 2024.

As an Electrical Design Trainee, your main role will be to design additions and alterations to the electricity distribution network to ensure the safe and reliable supply of energy to our customers

Our Traineeships are run over a three-year period, combining formal TAFE study and paid office-based work to enable you to gain the skills, competencies and experience required for an industry recognised trade qualification Advanced Diploma ESI (Electricity Supply Industry). Our traineeships enable work experience from Melbourne to rural and regional Victoria.

Upon successful completion of the Traineeship full time positions will be offered for the following roles:

Technical Design Officer, designing alterations to the network ready for construction

Project Manager, overseeing the delivery of project to connect customers or improve the network

Customer Requests Officer, providing quotations and information to new customers

Maintenance Officer, ensuring the network operates safely

Technical Drafting Officer, undertaking detailed construction and engineering drawings

To be eligible, our program pre-requisites are:

Year 11 (Unit 1 & 2) pass in Maths Methods OR Physics or;

Currently completing (or completed) a Diploma in an electrical field

*If you are currently completing a pre-requisite subject, you are eligible to apply, as long as it has been successfully completed by the end of the 2023 academic year.
