## Compound Words:

A *compound word* is made up of two separate words.



hair + brush = hairbrush



cup + cake = cupcake



snow + man = snowman



eye + lash = eyelash

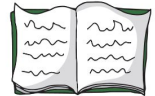


Sometimes we need to be like detectives and work out some things for ourselves.

Spelling  
'k' or 'c'  
Silent Letters  
'k', 'w', 'b'

Contractions:

A **contraction** shortens two words to make one word.

The **apostrophe** (') tells us there are missing letters.

I will → I'll

that is → that's

we are → we're

Use 'k' when the next letter is 'e', 'i', 'y' for words that have the /k/ sound.



kettle

kite

sky

Otherwise use 'c'.









carrot

cow

cut

Silent letters are letters that we can see but can't hear.

Silent k	Silent b	Silent w
 knee	 lamb	 write
 knit	 thumb	 sword

Reading Comprehension skills and strategies:

Summarising

A **summary** explains the most important facts or events in a story.



Summarising informative text

- ▶ What are the main ideas?

Summarising imaginative text

- ▶ Who are the main characters?
- ▶ Where and when is the story happening?
- ▶ What happened or what was the problem?
- ▶ How was the problem solved?

Main Idea

The **main idea** is what the paragraph or text is mostly about.



How do we find the main idea?

- Hint 1:** Look at the title and pictures
- Hint 2:** Read the first and last sentence
- Hint 3:** Look for repeated words
- Ask yourself:** What is the one main idea that all the details are about?
