Year 5

Welcome back. We hope you had a lovely winter break. The Year 5 Team is looking forward to a fun filled Term 3. This term our Inquiry unit is Science. We will be covering the areas of chemistry and biology. We have an excursion to the Botanic Gardens in week 4 that will focus on biomimicry. Students will learn about bio-inspired inventions and come up with their own nature inspired ideas for their inquiry project.

We also have a Mini Boss Studio Podcast incursion in week 4 that is focussed on design, produce and present a podcast episode. This aligns with our English unit of work where students will create their own 3-episode podcast. The students will work in teams to design, plan, write and create a fictional podcast that will explore the concepts of the intended audience, storytelling, design, collaboration, and podcasting as a mode.

Our Numeracy focus this term is multiplication and division. We encourage students to practise their automatic recall of multiplication facts at home. We are also learning about measurement, volume and capacity, analysing data and graphing and probability.

Every Friday, students will participate in athletics training and will need to wear appropriate clothing for these sessions. The House Athletics and District Athletics Carnivals will take place this term.

We look forward to Term 3 providing lots of exciting learning opportunities for the students and hope it will be a productive and fun experience for our students. If you have any queries do not hesitate to contact your child's classroom teacher.
