DAILY ROUTINE

Sign In

Children must be dropped-off and signed in by a parent/guardian or authorized person on the child's enrolment. For the safety and protection of children, we have strict procedures regarding drop-off and signing children into our service. For more information contact us 1300 366 235

Roll call

Please ensure your child arrives at the service before 9:00am for the official roll call.

Child-initiated activities

Children may participate in planned activities, or choose from a wide variety of activities and experiences such as art & crafts, music, construction, drama, imaginative play, foosball, arcade air hockey and basketball, indoor and outdoor games and much more.

Afternoon Snack

Our afternoon snack is a chance for children to wind down, rest and enjoy healthy and nutritious food such as fresh seasonal fruit, cheese toasties, quesadilla, banana muffins, crackers and dips, spanakopita and more.

Sign Out

Children will not be allowed to leave our service unless they have been signed out by a parent/guardian or authorized person on the child's enrolment. For the safety and protection of children, we have strict procedures regarding collection of children from our service. For more information contact us 1300 366 235

Late collection fee

Children are expected to be picked up no later than 6:00pm. A late collection fee of \$2.00 per minute (rounded down to whole minute) applies if a child is collected after the service closing time (i.e. 6:00pm).

EXCURSIONS

Drop-Off

Please ensure your child arrives at the service no later than the published arrival time for the specific excursion. Due to timings and scheduling, late arrivals may miss out. Children are not allowed to be dropped-off at the excursion venue.

Pick Up

Depending on the type of excursion and timings, children will usually return to the service between 2pm – 3pm, and can be collected any time after 3:00pm.

Spending Money

Strictly, NO spending money is allowed on excursions. Leapkids will not be responsible for any money lost or misplaced on an excursion.

What to bring

Please ensure your child brings the following:

- Packed lunch and named water bottle
- Suitable clothing for the weather
- Suitable footwear (closed-toe shoes) No thongs or sandals
- Wide brimmed hat (no baseball caps)
- Medication (if applicable)
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- Own sun screen (if preferred)

Incursions are held at the service at different times of the day. All incursions are provided by registered incursion providers who align with our philosophy and child safety standards, and delivered by qualified staff holding a working with children clearance.
