ABOUT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students selected for this scholarship program will participate in a dedicated 90 minute weekly session as part of a group of 8-10 students from years 4-6. Sessions will run after lunch and will be held in the art room at our Scotsburn Campus. Transportation for students will be provided as required.

This program will be led by Liz Morgan and will give students the opportunity to build on existing and learn new artistic skills. Students will work on individual pieces but will also collaborate with others on joint projects.

For this scholarship program, we're looking for students with a passion for the visual arts. Participation will require a commitment to practising learnt skills out of school.





SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrated commitment to the school's values (Respectful, Responsible and Kind)
- A demonstrated interest in the visual arts, both at school and outside of school.
- Demonstrated capability in the visual arts.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with others.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students currently in grades 3, 4 and 5 are now invited to apply for a spot in the 2024 Visual Arts Scholarship Program. Students from both campuses are invited to apply. The closing date for applications is Friday December 1st.

To apply, students need to write a letter explaining why they would like to be participate and why they should be selected. Whilst students can apply for more than 1 scholarship program, they can only be selected for 1.

Students are also invited to include extra documents that demonstrate their interest and capabilities in the visual arts.

Please submit applications to the office staff. We do expect each of the scholarship programs will be over-subscribed, so it's likely we'll organise an interview with each application to ensure the best candidates are chosen.
