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GIFTED & TALENTED IDENTIFICATION When being gifted and talented isn't always about the smarts

DOES YOUR child demonstrate:

AMAZING characteristics?	NOT SO AMAZING characteristics?
Extensive vocabulary	□Reluctant to write or read
Prefer the company of older children or adults	Difficulty in making friends with same-age- peers
□Intense curiosity	Extreme risk taking, always questioning
□Intense interests	Difficulty in changing tasks once 'involved'
□Great memory	Perfectionistic
□Long attention span or persistent	Easily bored
□Original and quirky thinking	□Melt downs when they can't do something
Early language skills	□Often frustrated when they aren't understood
Deep sense of fairness and moral justice	□Highly anxious: worrisome, fearful
□Great sense of humor	Disruptive in class
Prefers to organize people when playing games	□Can display impatience with others
□Great imagination	Day dreaming, often in 'lah lah land'
□Quick to grasp new concepts	□Resist or challenges drill and repetition
Mature sense of empathy towards others	□Highly sensitive - emotionally
Motivated to develop certain interests	Questions their abilities
Questions the 'meaning of life'	Demands your attention constantly

If you answer yes to at least 4 of these Amazing – and Not So Amazing – characteristics, you may need to stop and read this:

A gifted and talented child is not gifted and talented just at school, or just at home; they are gifted and talented 24 hours a day. Sometimes parenting and teaching children who display these characteristics can be a combination of intense joy and sheer frustration and



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exhaustion. Knowing how to support gifted and talented children in their good and not-sogood qualities allows them the space to thrive and develop - just like any other child!

The VAGTC is a for-purpose organization that provides learning support for both parents and educators in their journey towards creating home and learning environments for gifted and talented children to grow and flourish.
