#### NO EXAMS

#### BE PREPARED

- Please ensure you have all the required equipment – pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, geometrical equipment and a calculator. No 'white out' or similar is to be used.
- **PLEASE ENSURE DEVICES ARE CHARGED FOR ENGLISH EXAMS & PAT TESTING - THIS IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.**
- All students are to line up alphabetically and enter the exam room under the teacher's direction.
- You may bring a bottle of water into the exam room.
- **DEVICES** may only be taken into the exam room if **REQUIRED FOR EXAMS**.
- Students may take suitable reading material (no devices) into the exam room for quiet reading if the exam is completed.
- **EXAM CONDITIONS** apply for the duration of the exam.

#### PREPARING FOR EXAMS

1. Find out what you need to learn: ask your teacher if you will be tested on the whole year's work or just the second half of the year.
2. Make your study notes: you want to get your study notes finished as quickly as possible.
3. Learn your study notes: studying isn't just about reading—it's about remembering.
4. Practise the skills of the subject: do as many different questions, revision sheets, chapter reviews, sample essays or past examination papers as you can.
5. Review your test-taking techniques: this ensures you make the most of the time in the exam. Don't let nerves trip you up!

**And remember, don't leave your study until the last minute – get yourself organised well in advance.**
