KEEPING KIDS AT SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Targeted specifically at supporting students in the final two years of their secondary schooling, this Scholarship will cover some of the costs associated with fees, text books and other curriculum activities.



WENTWORTH & DISTRICT COMMUNITY BANK SCHOLARSHIP

In partnership with Chances, the Wentworth & District Community Bank has established a Scholarship to support a student from the Wentworth Shire to complete an undergraduate program of study.



NON-TERTIARY SCHOLARSHIP

This Scholarship is designed for young people aged 24 and under who wish to pursue sport, music or leadership at a state or national level. It will help cover the cost of equipment, training, competition and travel.



TERTIARY SCHOLARSHIP

If you are 24 or under and wish to go to university, TAFE or undertake an apprenticeship but cannot afford the costs associated with doing so, this Scholarship may be of assistance,
