PROGRAM DETAILS

WHEN: Future Me weekly sessions run from May - August, 2022

HOW: Blended delivery, online and on-campus (COVID permitted)

WHERE: CUC Goulburn, CUC Riverina, CUC Far West

COST: Free for In2Uni sponsored school students or students who meet the eligibility requirements below

WHO CAN APPLY?

You are invited to apply to the Year 12 Future Me Program if you meet the following criteria:

- You must be completing your HSC or IB in 2022 at a high school
- You must be attending an In2Uni sponsored school, OR meet one of the following criteria:
 - Completing the HSC in a rural or remote area
 - Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
 - On a permanent humanitarian visa or have refugee status
 - Currently experiencing financial hardship, disability/mental or physical health condition or social disadvantage that have impacted on your studies*
- You may be asked to provide details of these circumstances. Please contact us for more information if you are unsure whether you qualify.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

During the program, you will have access to and receive the following:

- Over 20 hours of free Year 12 and beyond skills development under the guidance of our UOW student mentors & Outreach staff
- By successfully completing the Future Me program, students will be eligible for a guaranteed interview or offer through the Early Admission program at either the University of Wollongong or UOW College (UOWC). Participation in this program will be taken into consideration when assessing UOW and UOWC course applications and outcomes. Interviews/offers may be for a course determined by UOW/ UOWC, dependant on academic performance. This may not be for the course listed in a student's Early Admissions application.
- Face-to-face and online subject resources to assist with the HSC.
- Assistance completing your post school admissions and UAC online applications.
- Mentoring to explore post-high school options, including higher education and pathways options based on your Year 12 academic performance.
- Year 12 Super Study Day - to prepare you for your HSC exams and transitioning from high school to what
