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Year 6 into Year 7: Key Dates

Broken Hill High School is excited your child/ward will be joining our school community in 2020. To ensure the transition between primary school and high school is an enjoyable experience. We have planned a number of events during Term 4, 2019 to allow you and your child/ward to become familiar with Broken Hill High School.

Below is an outline of these events.

Year 6 into Year 7 Information Night – Wednesday 23 October 2019, 6:00pm: Broken Hill High School will be hosting an Information Night for all parents and students joining our school community in 2020. This night will provide key information for 2020, as well as providing the opportunity for yourself and child/ward to meet key staff, undertake a brief tour of the school and ask questions you may have about starting high school in 2020.

Year Adviser Talk – **Wednesday 6 November 2019:** Year Adviser Hayley Miller will visit BHHS partner primary schools to discuss all things high school and answer any questions your child/ward may have about starting Year 7. Our peer support leaders will help with activities during the visit.

Picnic Day – Monday 2 December 2019: Year 7 students at Broken Hill High School each year take part in our Peer Support Program. The Peer Support Program creates a buddy system between your child/ward and their peer support leaders to ensure they are supported in their transition to high school. The Picnic Day provides the opportunity for your child/ward to meet their peer leaders for 2020 and partake in a number of peer activities.

Orientation Day – Tuesday 3 December 2019: Year 6 students will spend the entire day at Broken Hill High School. Your child/ward will again experience various subjects, different to those experienced during the Taste of High School Day, with the day finishing with a sports gala afternoon.

Term 5: The Term 5 Program focuses on primary school students attending Broken Hill High School to allow the students to become familiar with all things high school. Students will participate in Term 5 in one of the two blocks, Block one: 4 – 6 December 2019 or Block two: 9 – 11 December 2019. The dates for these visits will vary for each Primary School.
