How long is the walk?

The walk will take approximately 40–45 minutes at a relaxed pace.

What should I wear or bring?

Wear comfortable shoes and weather-appropriate clothing. A water bottle and small torch or phone light are recommended for evening visibility.

Is it safe to walk at night?

Yes — the walk is group-based, well-lit, and will be joined by local police and community leaders to ensure safety.

What happens if the event is rescheduled or canceled?
