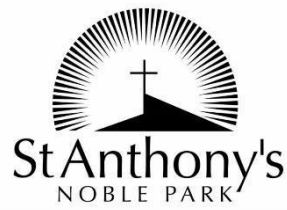




EUCHARIST PROGRAM 2023

Program requirements:

To receive the sacrament of Eucharist, you and your child **MUST** participate in the following 5 requirements.

1. Participate in a Religious Education Program either by:
 - (a) attending Resurrection or St Anthony's school
 - OR**
 - (b) for children attending Government or Private schools, participate in our parish Religious Education Program (Catechist Program).
2. Attend Mass on a nominated weekend to register your commitment to the program (dates below).
3. Attend **3 preparation meetings**,
 - A. the first one being for parents / guardian only;
 - B. the second for parents /guardian and children;
 - C. practice session to be held, this will be confirmed at the first meeting

Should a parent/guardian be unable to attend any of the meetings you **MUST** send **another adult** in your place. This adult cannot be another parent / guardian already participating in the program.

Please note: Ceremony Dates will be announced at the first meeting.

4. We encourage you to attend Mass each week during the program where the children will participate in Children's Liturgy. A minimum of **3 Masses** must be attended during the program (more information at meeting).
5. Complete children's workbooks. Workbooks will be corrected by the RE team. Books will need to be up to standard. (Books distributed at the meeting).

These requirements are **not negotiable**. If you find that you are unable to complete these requirements, then you may need to consider whether this is the most suitable time for your child to receive the Sacrament this year.
