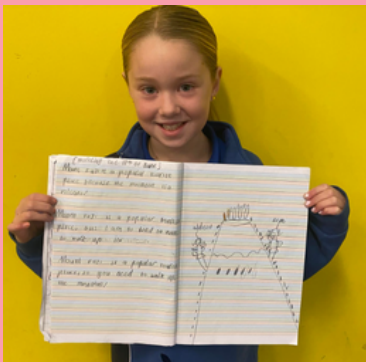

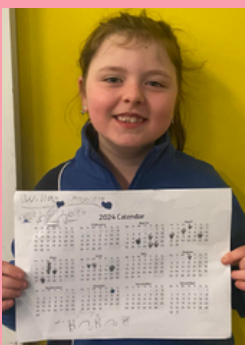
Literacy

Students have been learning about Japan in our Content Knowledge sessions. In Text Construction we have been applying this knowledge to construct Haiku Poems and Information Reports. Our conjunction sentence practice has helped extend sentence structure and information included while writing information reports.



Numeracy

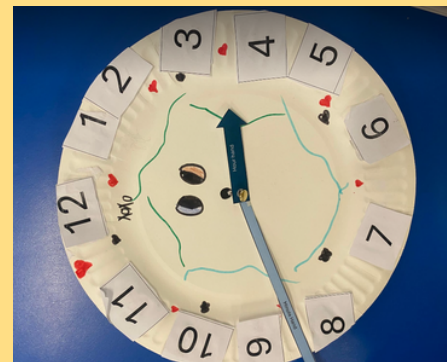
In Numeracy students have been learning about Time. Students have created their own personal clock to assist in telling time. Students have also been using calendars to mark out dates and find different events. Students have also experimented with stopwatches in order to further develop their understanding of time duration.



Skill in Focus Telling Time

Telling the time: At home you can assist your child in telling the time by getting them to read clocks both digital and analogue. Our main focus in Grade 1/2 is o'clock and half past times with some quarter past and quarter to times. If your child is confident with these, you can extend them by getting them to read 5 minute interval or to the minute times.

Idea: Take the batteries out of an analogue clock that you have at home or you could make one of the clocks we have made in class using a paper plate.
