Year 7 2021 Transition: Applications for Year 7 enrolments for 2021 **have been extended to Friday 29 May 2020** due to COVID-19. Parents will need to return their preference form to their primary school by this date along with the 'Out of Zone Application' form – if applicable.

Primary schools are in the process of distributing these forms to Grade 6 families. The form can also be found via: bit.ly/DETtransition

Out of Zone Application: All schools now have a zone. For new enrolments coming into Year 7, we anticipate that we will have sufficient capacity to be able to take students from outside of our zone following the department's placement policy.

Our school zone is available on findmyschool.vic.gov.au.

Findmyschool.vic.gov.au hosts the most up-to-date information about Victorian school zones for 2021.

Students residing in Mordialloc Colleges zone are guaranteed a place at our school, which is determined on the basis of your permanent residential address.
