## Physical:

\*Practise the correct formation of the upper and lowercase anticlockwise lettersAa (Week 3). Cc (Week 4).
\* Make an effort to recycle & reuse materials.
\* Throw rubbish in the correct bin.
\* Be mindful of the weather & wear a sun hat outside.

#### Literacy:

\* Practise the graph /q/ and /u/ as in 'queen' (Week 3).
\* Identify the new common words: so, much, holiday (Week 3).
\* Practise the graph /a/ as in 'swan' (Week 4).
\* Identify the new common words: where, what (Week 4).
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\* Write a story that has a beginning, a series of things happening and an ending.
\* Notice what simple dialogue is like and use understandings to decide how dialogue should be

## Numeracy:

\* Represent practical situations to model subtraction.

\* Count backwards by is initially from 20, moving from any starting point.

\* Show the relationship between addition and subtraction.

\* Become familiar with vocabulary associated with subtraction.

\* Identify and order Australian notes and coins.
