Pre-Paid Fete Vouchers

- ➤ We have \$10 "bundles" of vouchers made up of "\$1 each" tickets, available this year.
- The vouchers can be used at any stall or activity instead of money, *except* for some Food and drinks.
- As the children make a purchase the ticket/s they have spent are removed off the bundle.
- The bundle is attached to a ribbon, which allows the children to hang the bundle around their necks.
- > This is intended to save the children having to walk around with lots of money in their hands on the night
- We encourage parents to write their child's name on the back of the vouchers in case these are lost
- ➤ We strongly encourage everyone to make use of these vouchers- it saves a lot of time and effort for the organisers in counting money and arranging mountains of change. It is easier for the stallholders to handle.
