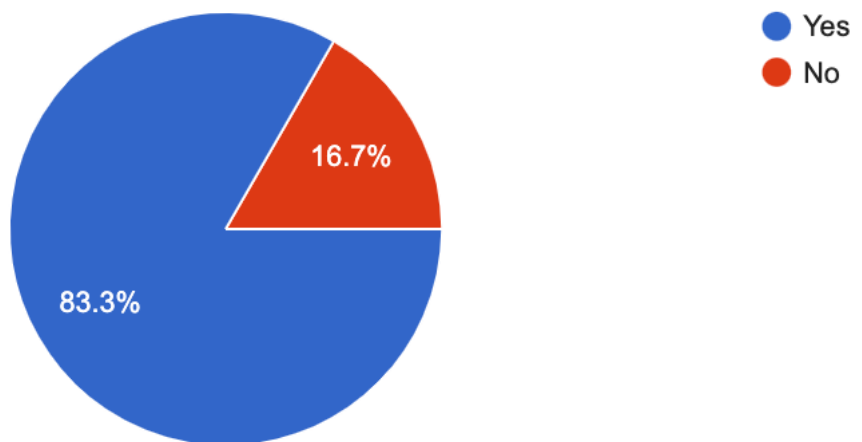

We thank everyone who participated in the surveys and were part of the process of reviewing Galilee's Homework Policy.

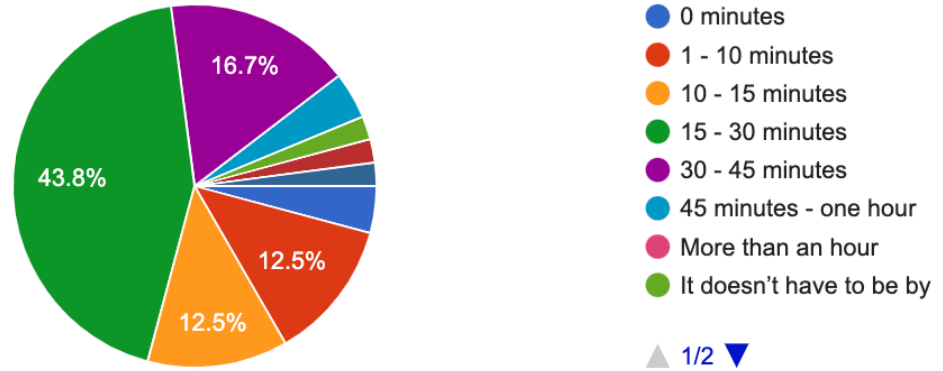

Do you think homework should be given?

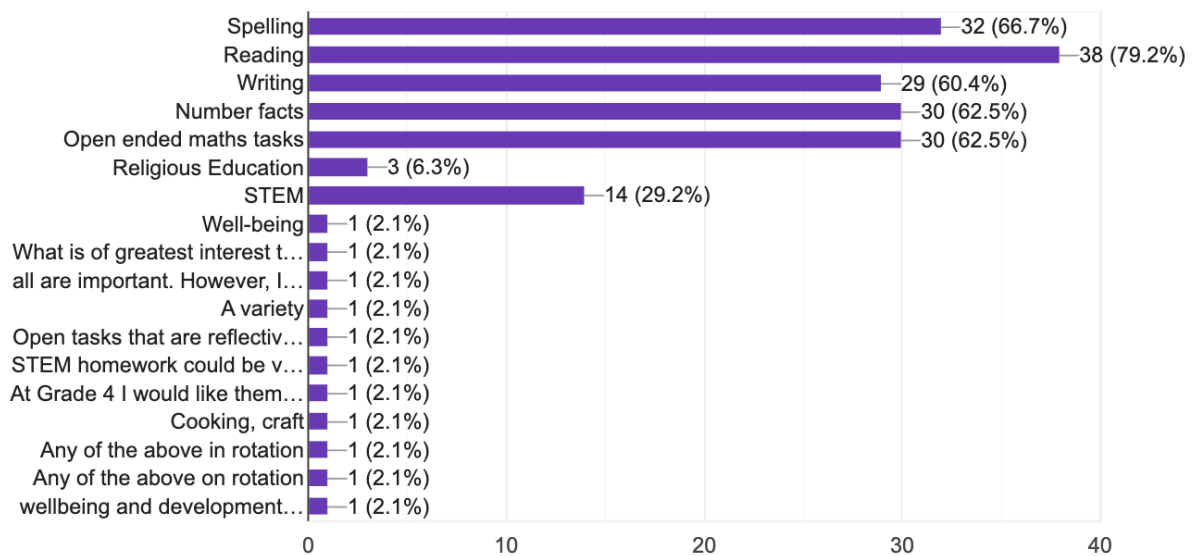


How much time do you think children should spend on homework each day?

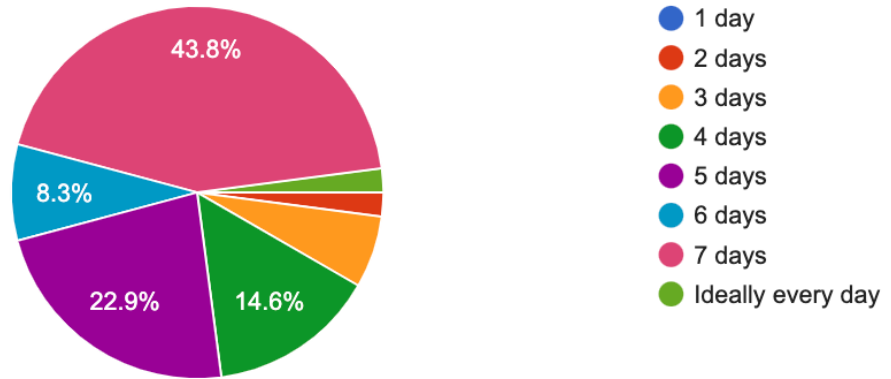


What homework activities do you think are valuable?

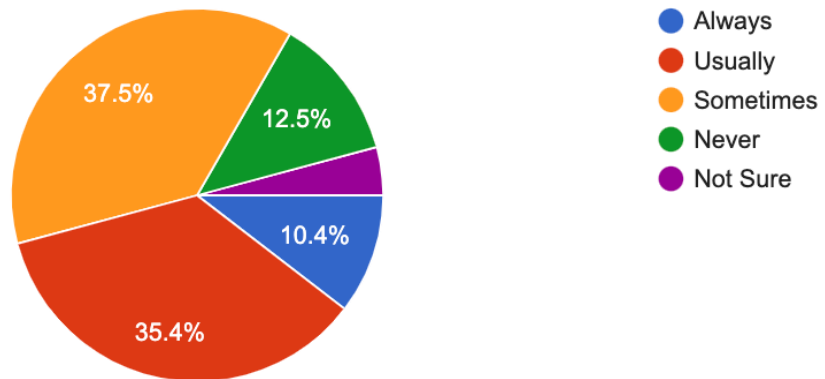

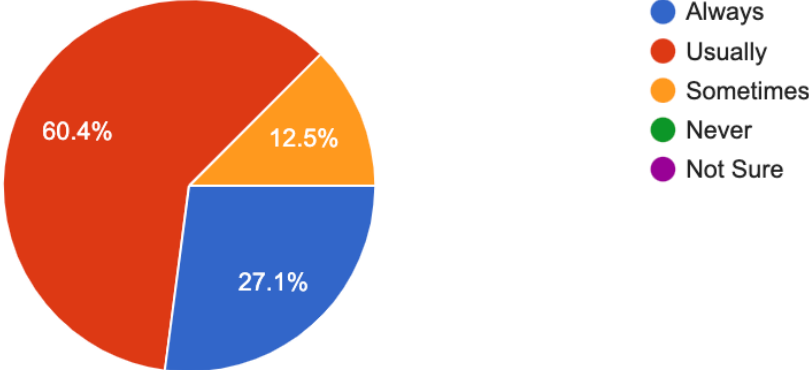
How many days a week do you think children should read at home?



My child enjoys their homework.

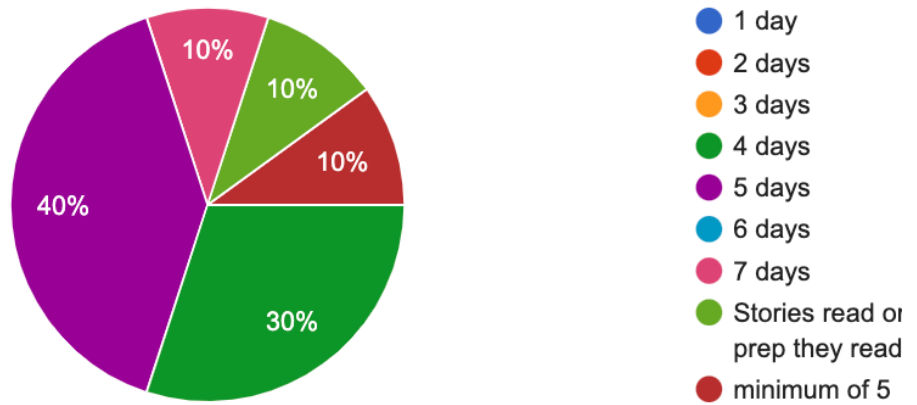


I know how to support my child with their homework.

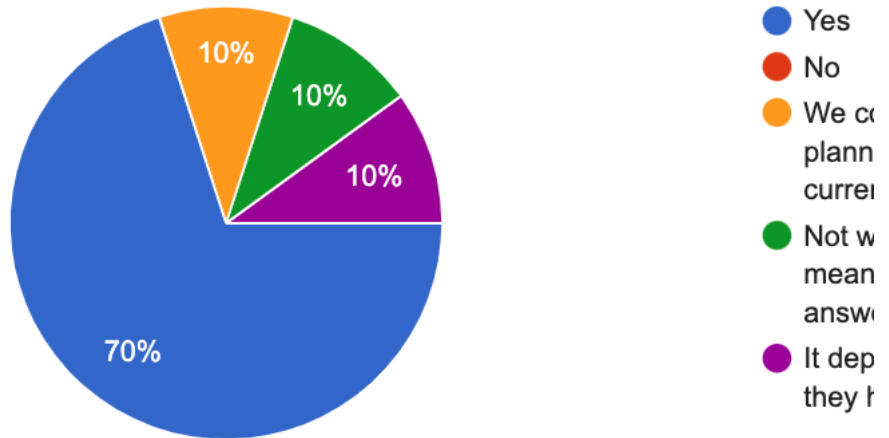

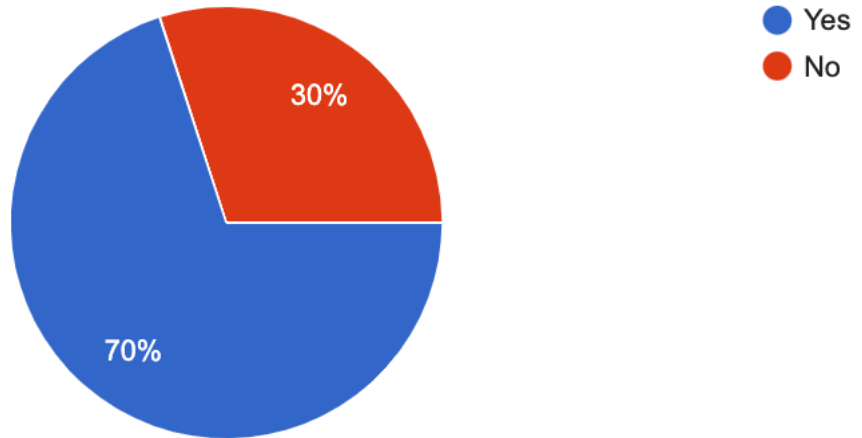
How many days a week do you think students should read at home?



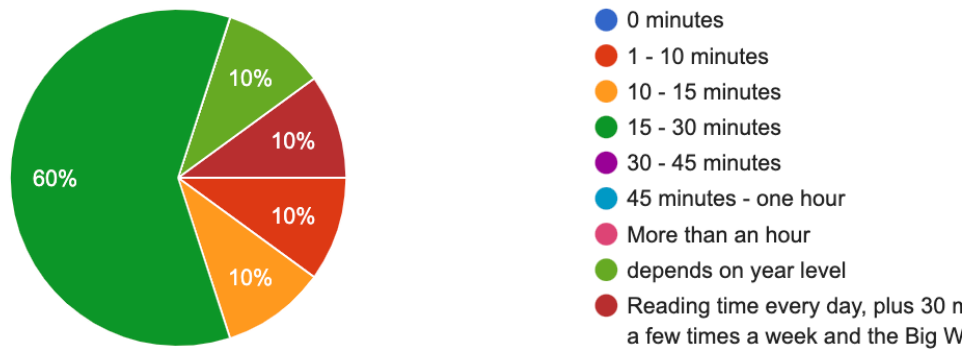
Do you find homework beneficial to your student's learning?



Would you prefer to homework to be given?

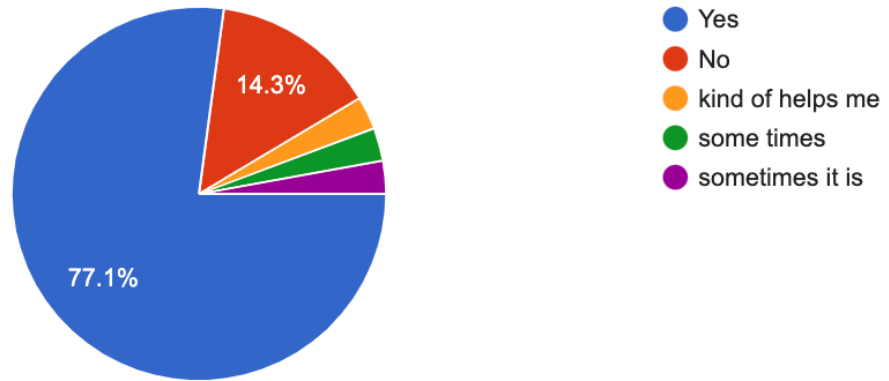


How much time do you think students should spend on homework each day?

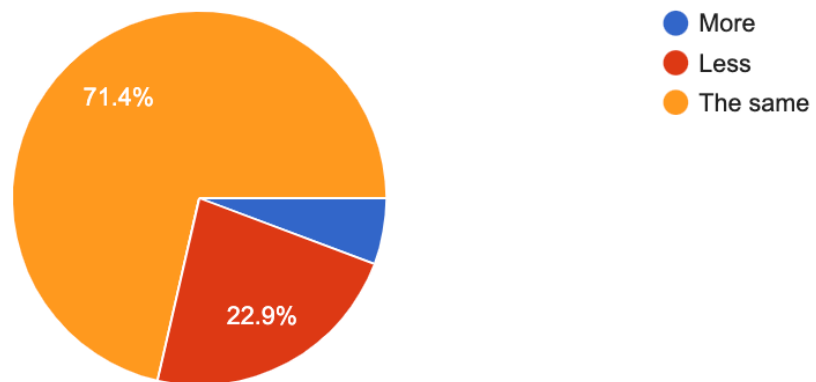

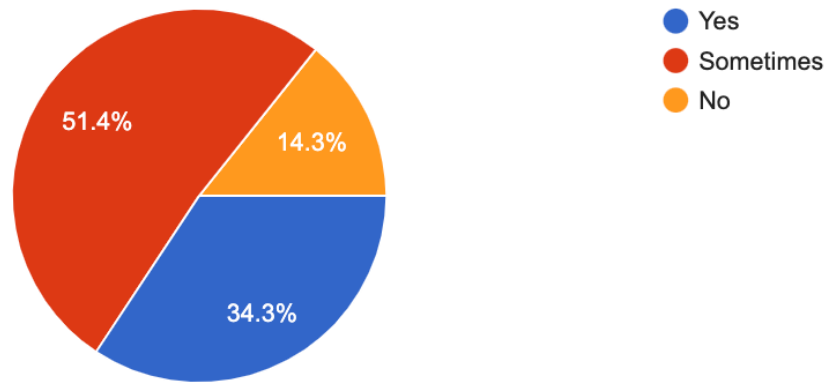
Do you think homework is helping your learning?



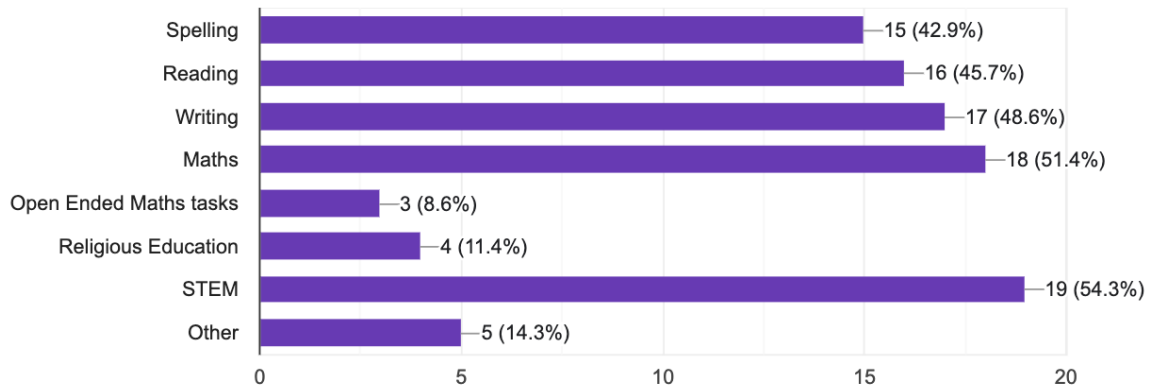
Would you prefer more, less or the same amount of homework?

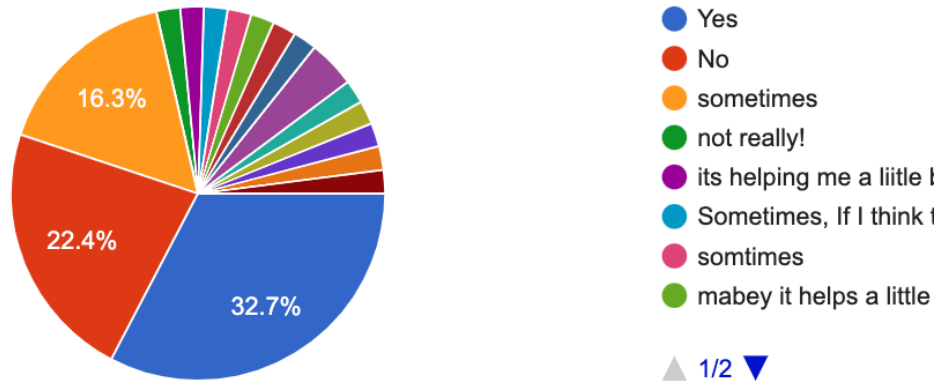


What learning areas would you like to see in your homework?

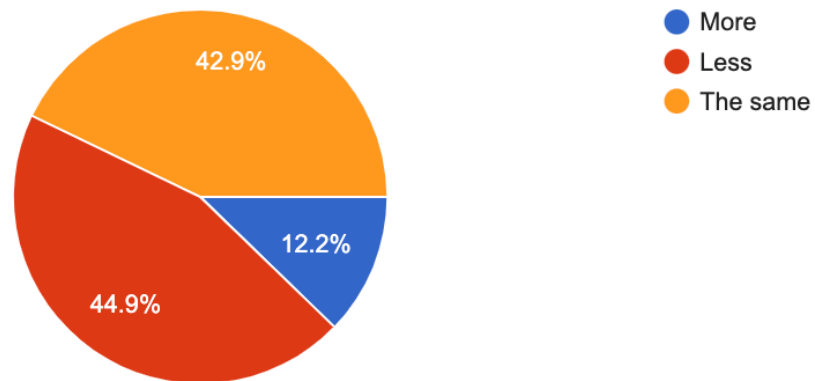

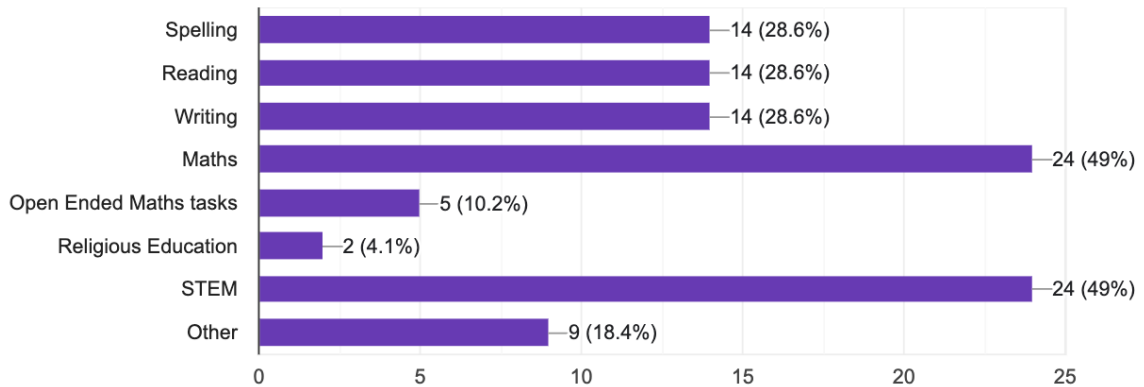

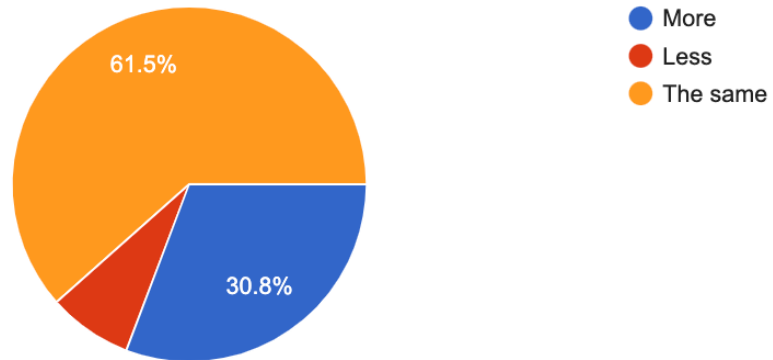

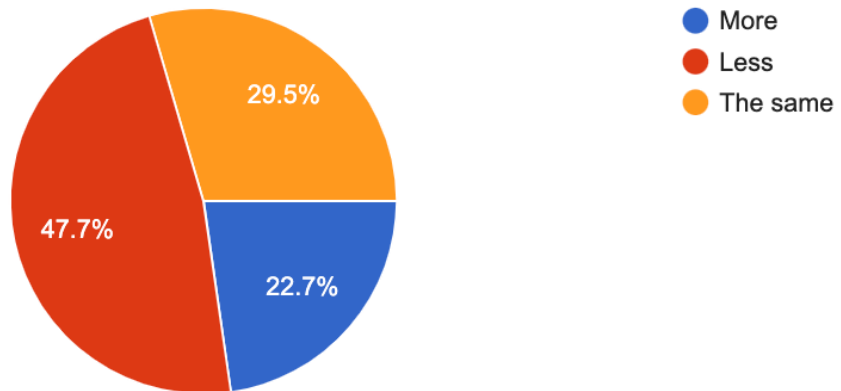
