NON-NEGOTIABLE MINOR AND MAJOR BEHAVIOUR



MINOR

1. **PHYSICAL CONTACT** without the intent to harm (rough play which includes pushing, shoving and wrestling etc.)
2. **DAMAGING SCHOOL PROPERTY** drawing on school property including furniture, walls and equipment, scratching denting.
3. **LEAVING THE LEARNING SPACE** without permission.
4. **ABUSIVE LANGUAGE** indirect without intent (swearing, name calling).
5. **TAKING OTHERS PROPERTY WITHOUT PERMISSION** - including removing items from learning space.
6. **POSSESSION OF PROHIBITED ITEMS** mobile device, gum, aerosol sprays etc.
7. **DISRUPTION** interrupting teaching and learning (backchat, calling out/interrupting, inappropriate gestures, lying).
8. **NON-COMPLIANCE** failing to follow instructions.
9. **LACK OF PUNCTUALITY** being late to the learning space.
10. **DRESS CODE VIOLATION** not wearing full school uniform.

MAJOR



1. **PHYSICAL CONTACT** with intent to harm (kicking, punching, biting, spitting, scratching, choking, tackling, holding down/back).
2. **DAMAGING SCHOOL PROPERTY** including deliberate vandalism (breaking of windows, furniture, technology, graffiti, flipping tables/chairs, damaging toilets/bathroom).
3. **LEAVING THE SCHOOL GROUNDS** without permission.
4. **ABUSIVE LANGUAGE** directed with intent (swearing, name calling.)
5. **THEFT** including (staff/student personal possessions, technology and/or money).
6. **POSSESSION AND/OR USE OF WEAPONS**
7. **SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR** including verbal sexualised language and/or behaviour directed with intent at staff/students.
8. **BULLYING** Repeated, intentional and targeted behaviour.
 - **DIRECT PHYSICAL** with intent to harm (kicking, punching, pinching, biting, spitting, choking, tackling, holding down/back).
 - **DIRECT VERBAL** name calling, teasing, racist remarks, intimidation, threatening remarks.
 - **INDIRECT BULLYING** rumours, daring embarrassing mimicking sarcasm, encouraging others to exclude someone, ganging up.
 - **CYBER BULLYING** direct verbal or indirect bullying behaviours using digital technology.
