

# **ACC HALL OF FAME (THE ARTS) 2016 SUBMISSION INFORMATION**

#### **AIMS:**

The aims of this concept are:

- to be a beacon for current students involved in the Arts (expanding the horizons of boys education)
- to promote the Arts within our schools, our Association and the wider community
- to enable schools to reconnect with past students

#### **ART FORMS:**

- The "Arts" Hall of Fame shall incorporate the following Art Form categories and sub-categories:
  - ➤ Literary Arts Creative Nonfiction, Creative Writing, Playwriting, Poetry, Prose, Short Stories
  - ➤ Media Arts Animation, Audio Documentary, Documentary, Film, Interactive Design, Multimedia, New Media, Podcast, Video, Web-Based Work
  - ➤ Music Composition, Conducting, Hip-hop, Instrumental Performance, Jazz, Musical Directing, Opera, Rapping, Singing, Songwriting, Vocal Performance
  - ➤ Performance Acting, Cinema, Dance, Movement, Musical Theatre, Performance Art, Spoken Word, Theatre
  - ➤ Visual Arts Cartoon / Comic Illustration, Digital Art, Drawing, Graphic Design, Installation, Mixed Media, Murals, Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Screenprinting, Sculpture.

When nominating a former student for inclusion in the Hall of Fame, you will need to specify which of the categories and sub-categories their nomination falls under.

## **CRITERIA:**

Criteria for induction is based on three key aspects:

- 1. must be a former student of an ACC member school.
- 2. must have received significant national or international recognition by an approved Arts institution and / or by the relevant Arts community.
- 3. must not be publicly in contradiction to the aims and objectives of Catholic Education

Additional information will need to be supplied for criteria item 2.

### **SUBMISSION PROCESS:**

- Nominations to be submitted using the online ACC submission form: http://form.jotform.com/form/11631600342
- Schools nominating a former student need to supply details supporting their nomination.
- Schools may submit up to 2 nominations each year.
- Submissions will be collated and discussed at the ACC Arts Hall of Fame meeting on October 28th.
- Nominations will then be ratified by Principals at their November meeting.
- Successful nominees will be added to the ACC Handbook and website under the Hall of Fame section.
- Inductees to be presented with a Certificate from the ACC schools to be provided with the certificates and then they can arrange to present it to their inductee in the most appropriate way.

Deadline for submissions is FRIDAY OCTOBER 21st, 2016.
