## Subtraction Using the Correct Maths Language



## 50

$-33$
50 take away 33
50 minus 33

## Step 1

We always start in the ones column when subtracting.
We say:

- Zero takeaway 3 ones. We don't have enough ones. We now need to move 1 ten from the tens column and regroup (trade) for 10 ones (remember to record how many tens you now have in the tens column).
- Now that we have 10 ones we can now takeaway 3 ones. So 10 ones takeaway 3 ones leaves 7 ones.
- We write the answer 7 in the ones column.


## Step 2

Now we move to the next column, the tens column.
We say:

- 4 tens takeaway 3 tens leaves 1 ten.
- We write the answer 1 in the tens column.

The answer is 17.

We follow the same process when we have bigger numbers
