As a mentee, you will be matched with a current Monash student who will mentor you throughout Year 11 and 12. You will be required to meet at least 10 times during the year with your allocated mentor.

Eligibility:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, be an Australian permanent resident or hold a Permanent Humanitarian visa, a Safe Haven Enterprise visa, a Temporary Protection visa or a Bridging visa A or E
- Be in Year 11 or 12 in 2021
- Attend an [Access Monash partner school](#) (Frankston High School is one)
- Be considering studying at university
- Be the first in your family to attend university or, have a low income or, be an Indigenous Australian, or live in a low socio-economic area
- Have your application endorsed by your school
- Have parent/guardian permission

Note: If you are not first in family to attend university, Monash has stated they would encourage all students interested in the program to still apply. We will assess their whole application, and despite not being first in family, they still may be successful in their application.

- Gain insight into university life
- Clarify future goals
- Explore your study and career options
- Gain support and study tips from someone who has completed VCE
- Exclusive access to some Monash programs
