

Level 4 Homework Matrix – Weeks 5 & 6

Foundation – Reading + 4 tasks/fortnight

L1/2 – Reading + 5 tasks/fortnight

L3/4 – Reading + 7 tasks/fortnight

L5/6 – Reading + 9 tasks/fortnight

Tasks will be completed in student homework books and handed in to the teacher, to be signed, two weeks later on a Friday morning (even weeks). Teachers will sign homework books.
