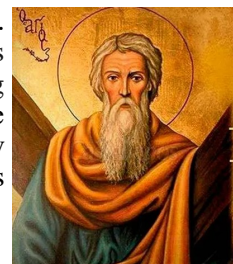

WELCOME TO ADVENT 2021



ADVENT: Advent is the period leading up to Christmas. It starts on the Sunday nearest to 30 November and ends on the fourth Sunday before 25 December.

The word 'advent' means 'coming'. It is a time of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus. Many Advent customs involve counting the days until Christmas begins.

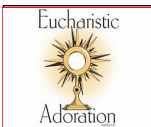
Some churches have an Advent wreath with five candles, one for each of the 4 Sundays, the 5th candle is lit on Christmas day. There are different readings on each of the four Sundays leading up to Christmas Day.

Purple is the usual liturgical colour used during Advent. Some Christian denominations use blue (representing hope) as an alternative colour.

Advent reminds Christians of the sacred meaning of Christmas. Despite the secular preparations taking place, e.g. buying presents and going to parties, Advent reminds Christians to remember and prepare for the birth of Jesus.

One important aspect of Advent in the Roman Catholic Church, especially before 16 December, is to prepare for the Second Coming of Christ in judgement at the end of time.
