

Educational Costs

Tuition Fees

Accounts will be issued once per year. Fees for 2020 will be **\$1840.00 per family**. (May be paid in three instalments of \$610.00 in Term 1, \$610.00 in Term 2 and \$620.00 in Term 3.)

These fees are used for

- Capital repayments
- Recurrent payments of all utilities, e.g. heating, air conditioning, cleaning, maintenance.

Cash payment may be made in person at the office or if you are paying by cheque or credit card, complete tear off slip at bottom of statement, put in a **clearly marked envelope** and send through tub system to office. **EFTPOS facilities are also available.**

School Levies 2020

Levies for 2021 are payable at the end of previous year, e.g. 2020 for 2021. These are used for: -

- Day to day school running costs, e.g. postage, school stationery, fee statements, etc.
- Resources for classroom use in various curricular areas e.g. Religious Education, Literacy and Numeracy
- Information Technology, Physical Education Equipment, Library Materials, etc.
- Excursions
- Mathletics (Online Interactive Maths Resource)
- Wuska (Online Reading Resource)
- Photocopying/paper costs for class materials, etc.....
