TRANSPORT:

Transport to and from the UQ Tennis Centre will be by the College minibus. Students are to assemble at the Tuckshop area at **7:00am** to have their name marked off the roll before departure. The bus will then return to Clayfield College, Bayview Terrace, at approximately **3:00pm**.

All students are expected to travel on the bus to the UQ Tennis Centre. Students may travel home with their parents/caregivers but must check out with the Clayfield College supervising teacher before leaving. All students are required to stay for the presentation.

Food and water for the day - please note, girls may require more than 1 drink bottle and these bottles must be clearly named
Any necessary medication eg. Asthma puffer/epi-pen

SPECTATORS: As a precautionary measure you will be asked to sign in with one of our Clayfield representatives and receive a badge so that each school is aware of who is present. Please observe social distancing at this event and spectate from outside of the court areas only. The venue has some seating and shaded cover; however, it is advised to bring your own seating and weather protection. There will be a café in operation serving hot and cold drinks and café food for spectators only.

A message will be placed on the Clayfield College App if the weather is inclement to notify you if the tournament has been cancelled or if the bus is arriving back at Clayfield College at a different time.
