

Cohort Specific Information & upcoming news

- We are fortunate to have full-time teaching assistants which maintains our 15:1 ratio.
- While instruction is run by the teachers, assistants support with managing behaviour, support students who need extra support to get started and then running small workshops that are pre-planned by the teachers.
- In weeks 6 and 7 the students will be separated into grades. This is to ensure that throughout NAPLAN our Spanish Bilingual Program is not impacted - New Timetables will be provided
- Interschool Sports runs from week 3 to 7. Students that are not participating stay on

site with either Karren or Lisa working on independent maths and literacy.

- Buddies run every Friday on non-whole school assembly and is now run in houses.

Weekly Timetable

- 50/50 Bilingual program
- Minimize transition thus start and finish with same teacher with 1 transition between session 3 and 4 each day.

Take Home Literacy Program

Read Theory. Students have been assigned a weekly assignment. They read the article and then answer the questions. This will take no more than 15 minutes per night

Within a week it is the expectation that students will read a minimum of 3 Spanish texts on Raz Kids. These are leveled.

From time-to-time other work might come home, however if you would like to do a little extra, your children could do 10 minutes of Essential Assessment or some free writing.
