Calling of Candidates (The candidates will be called each by name; and stand)

Fr Thaddeus: - My Lord, I present to you the children of our Parish who wish to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

[The candidates remain standing until the Bishop tells them to sit]

Homily by the Bishop

THE RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES [Candidates for Confirmation stand]

Bishop: Do you renounce Satan, and all his works and empty promises?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of

the Virgin Mary, suffered death and was buried, rose again from the dead

and is seated at the right hand of the Father?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who today

through the Sacrament of Confirmation is given to you in a special way

just as he was given to the Apostles on the day of Pentecost?

Candidates: I do.

Bishop: Do you believe in the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints,

the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

Candidates: I do.

The Bishop: This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church.

We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.

All: Amen.

Laying on of Hands:

The Bishop: Dearly beloved, let us pray to God the almighty Father, for these, his adopted sons and daughters, already born again to eternal life in Baptism, that He will graciously pour out the Holy Spirit upon them to confirm them with his abundant gifts, and through his anointing conform them more fully to Christ, the Son of God.

[Then the Bishop lays hands over all the candidates extending his hands over them]

The Bishop: Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who brought these your servants to new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, freeing them from sin: send upon them, O Lord, the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete; give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and fortitude, the spirit of knowledge and piety; fill them with the spirit of the fear of the Lord. Through Christ our Lord.

THE ANOINTING WITH CHRISM

[The sacred Chrism oil is brought to the Bishop. Each of those to be confirmed goes to the Bishop. The sponsor who presents the person to be confirmed places his/her <u>right</u> hand on his/her <u>shoulder</u> and hands the Confirmation Card to Fr. Thaddeus who, in turn, clearly says the Confirmation Name chosen.]

Bishop: [Name], be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit. Newly confirmed: Amen.

Bishop: Peace be with you

Newly confirmed: And with your spirit.

CORONAVIRUS UPDATE: 80% REOPENING ROADMAP OCTOBER 2021

Now that the 80% fully vaccinated rate being has been reached, the requirements under the NSW government roadmap have again changed. **CHURCH ENTRY** • Entry to churches is open for both fully vaccinated and not fully vaccinated • QR code check in is still required and an alternative written sign in option • Social distancing is required at 4m2 • Masks are required inside the church but not outside. • Singing is not permitted by congregants but there may be a sole singer if they are fully vaccinated or a choir of up to 10 people who are: fully vaccinated and socially distanced from each other and are separated from the parishioners.
