Important OSHC information

We have had another fun and exciting term 2 Children have enjoyed the activities from our program, which included constructive play, a variety of art and craft, outdoor games, gym experiences, gardening as well as many other activities. Children have had many opportunities to show their creative side and as a result our room is looking bright and colorful!

<u>Pupil Free day</u>: Parents please be aware there is a Pupil Free day on Monday 25th July (first week back of Term 3).I f you require care for that day please place your child's name on the list located in the OSHC room. The last day for expressions of interest will be Friday 1st July 2016. Please note the service requires a minimum of 15 bookings to operate and the full day fee is \$60. Parents will be notified on Monday 4th July 2016 if the service will be operating.

<u>School Gates</u>: Please be aware that the school is having new electronic gates installed during the 1st week of the July vacation care period. Parents will not have access to the carpark and therefore will be required to park on Malurus avenue and enter via the pedestrian gate.

<u>OSHC Garden</u>: The OSHC garden is now complete and flourishing thanks to all of the recent rain and sunshine! The children have been taking care of the garden by ensuring it gets watered and fertilized regularly and are monitoring each piece carefully. Many vegies such as the lettuces & some herbs are ready to be pulled up and eaten, which is very exciting for the educators and children to taste their 'handy work' throughout the term!

<u>Vacation Care Program</u>: Come and join in the fun, as we still have some spots available for these July school holidays. If you wish to attend, be quick so you don't miss out! Vacation Care booklets are available from the OSHC room, front office or online on the LNPS website.

<u>Term 2 Payments</u>: Parents, who have outstanding fees for Term 2, will be required to finalize their account before the commencement of Term 3, 2016. Parents who fail to organise these payments will be unable to enroll their child/ren until payments have been paid.

<u>OSHC/Vac Care Payments</u>: The service has received payments of EFT into the OSHC/VAC CARE account with no reference name. We ask those parents who use this method of payment to check their invoice. Please ensure you are writing your name or your child's name as the reference.

<u>Yearly Permanent booking forms 2016</u>: Parents, please be aware that our permanent booking forms are for the year, which means sessions booked in from Term 1, will roll over for the reminder of the year. There is no need to fill out another form unless you need to change days/sessions or cancel care. Forms can be collected from the OSHC room, front office or online on the LNPS website.

<u>Emails</u>: Emails to the Director will be only attended between the hours of 8.00am- 4.00pm on Monday to Friday. If the matter is urgent please contact the service between 7am-6.00pm on 8443 5308 or 0411 236 014.

<u>Active After School</u>: If your child is going to attend an after school activity please notify the service in advanced. If our educators have not been notified by parent/caregiver children will not be allowed to leave the service.

<u>Absentees</u>: Parents who have children attending OSHC but are absent from school or picked up early from school, need to notify the service by phone on 8443 5308 ASAP as we have children on the waiting list.

MY TIME, OUR PLACE



OSHC Program Information:

This term the children have engaged in activities focussing on 'Nature' and 'Sensory Experiences' The children were encouraged to participate in a wide variety of experiences that provided opportunities to socialise with others, build confidence and self esteem, extend communication skills, develop emotional well being and feel connected with the world.

The children were able to adapt to the unpredictable weather throughout the term. Some days were spent outside in the sunshine with oval sports & playground games whilst other days we utilised the activity room with the Playstation, Wii dolls house, beanie kids and puppet shows. In the gym the children were able to use the gymnastic mats, footballs, soccer balls, tennis, t-ball, basketballs, netballs, Frisbees, large bouncy balls and roller boards.

The children participated in quiet indoor experiences such as lego, i-Pads, laptops, board games, dominos, magnetic pieces, cards, and range of art and craft experiences such as making necklaces, puffy paint, sponge painting and drawing.

In week 4 we had a couple of visitors from Bunnings attend our service to assist the children in planting our OSHC garden, it was a wonderful 'hands on' experience giving the children education about planting, care and responsibility of the veggies that would be used at our service in the near future.

During our 'Sensory Experiences' focus the children made their own sensory bottles with coloured water, googley eyes, beads, feathers, coloured sand and glitter. A number of children helped educators to make 'sensory containers' which included varied items such as kinetic sand, pasta, rice, lentils, beans, cars, coloured rocks & gems as well as shells and small mermaid dolls. These containers were a complete hit with the children and took the interest of everyone who attended OSHC. We also made sand foam, gloop, playdough and stress balls. The children were also involved in several cooking experiences such as 'Earth Day' cupcakes, decorating biscuits and making damper. All were delicious and enjoyable treats!
