

PARENT PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS 2023

Dear Parent/Guardian,

South Melbourne Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our voluntary financial contributions for 2023.

Victorian State Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard Victorian curriculum, and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Department of Education and Training Victoria has been working with schools to strengthen the parent payment policy.

The payments are divided into three areas:

- 1. Curriculum Contributions (essential student learning items)
- 2. Extra Curricular Items and Activities (optional items and activities such as camps and excursions, that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the curriculum. Extra-curricular items and activities are provided on a user-pays basis)
- 3. Other Contributions (supporting non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives)

Support and contributions from families allows us to offer a wider range of subjects and special curriculum experiences for your children, including enhanced digital learning opportunities, new learning resources for literacy and maths, offer effective first aid for all students and arrange individual student supplies and class bulk supplies. Every effort has been made to minimise the costs; however, any increase is due to genuine price rise for individual items and resources.

These funds are voluntary, but they allow SMPS to continue to offer a broad curriculum and a wide range of programs for our community's children.

You can also make tax-deductible voluntary contributions towards targeted funding streams such as the Library Fund and Building Fund. In 2023, with your donations, we hope to continue to create an inviting library space and, to install acoustic treatment in the gym to complement the audio-visual system our families funded in 2021 and 2022.

Financial Support for Families

South Melbourne Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- CSEF (Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund) provided by DE&T and is automatically paid to family accounts. Applications are available via the school and families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible to apply for \$125 of funding each year.
- Access to States School Relief for support with clothing/uniforms.

- Second-hand and low-cost options (e.g. school clothing pool, low cost suppliers)
- Local community supports.

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access
 to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the
 requirements of the Curriculum. This includes the Victorian Curriculum F-10, the
 Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) and the Victorian Pathways Certificate.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

• Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

 Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
