<b>Arts &amp; Crafts</b>	<b>\$20 per student</b>	Supplies for art and craft, drama, music and visual arts.
<b>Online Digital Subscriptions</b>	<b>\$40 per student</b>	Roselea PS uses a variety of online programs to enhance student learning in class.
<b>Teaching &amp; Learning Resources</b>	<b>\$40 per student</b>	To support teaching, learning & individual needs of students.
<b>Technology Levy</b>	<b>\$30 per student</b>	This will be used in the maintenance and updating of technology hardware and software.
<b>Workbooks &amp; Reading Books</b>	<b>\$30 per student</b>	This fund is used to enable the school to supply relevant class specific workbooks, dictionaries, reading books etc. for use in class and at home.
<b>Sport Levy</b>	<b>\$10 per student</b>	This fund covers the NSW Primary schools Sports Association affiliation fees

<b>Voluntary P&amp;C Contribution</b>	<b>\$50 per family</b>	Through donations from parents, our Parents & Citizens Association provides extra equipment for the benefit of your child.
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Our school welcomes your voluntary contributions, as they will significantly improve resources for students. Separate notes for excursions, sport, camps and in school activities will be sent home during the year. Extracurricular activities are additional to school contributions. If your child attends after school dance class and some of our choir and dance groups, please be aware these activities are voluntary and involve a financial commitment not included in school contributions.

## VOLUNTARY GENERAL SCHOOL CONTRIBUTION
