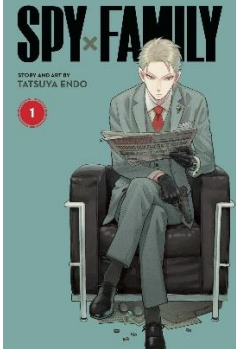


RECOMMENDED READS

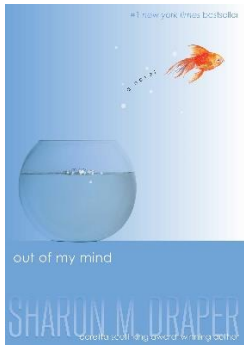


Spy X Family 1 **by Tatsuya Endo**

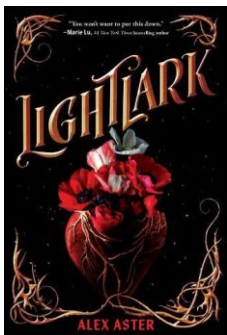


Bleach **by Noriaki Kubo**
