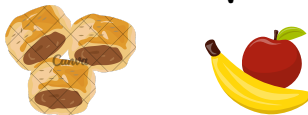

Help decorate the OSHC space for easter with decorations, crafts, signs and more!



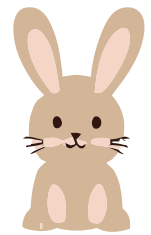

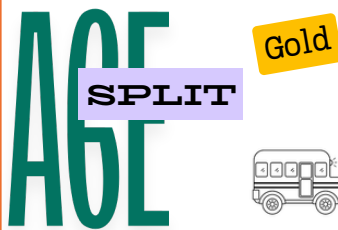
