


#### Schools

We provide workshops and training for schools to provide an understanding of not just Aspergers but typical behavioural patterns of a range of neurodivergent conditions. We suggest practical strategies for schools to nurture and support their students to help them thrive at school and beyond.



#### Workplaces

We provide workshops and training for employers to help them understand Aspergers autistic employees, to accept and appreciate the diverse views and skills they can bring to teams, and to recommend options for support to ensure they continue to be included and supported, and that they have access to meaningful work.



### Government submissions and roundtables

We listen to our community. We gather their feedback on issues important to you, and we work with government at all levels to create understanding and positive change for Aspergers autistic individuals, your families and your communities.


