ST PIUS X COLLEGE COVID-19 SUMMER SPORTS PROTOCOLS TERM 1 2022 as at 9 February 2022

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at St Pius X College.

Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend St Pius X College sports fixtures as either a player, staff or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- Have returned a positive RAHT or PCR Test in the last 7 days
- are a close contact of a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk – including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals

NB - If a player becomes unwell during a game, the player must be removed from the game and leave the venue.

Attendance

Only the following people will be permitted onsite:

- Players
- Coaches – must be fully vaccinated
- Faculty/Sport staff – must be fully vaccinated
- Match Officials – must be fully vaccinated
- Medical staff – must be fully vaccinated
- Family spectators

It is recommended that any eligible person visiting St Pius X College sports facilities should be fully vaccinated or have a valid medical exemption (Medical Certificate required).

Though density limits no longer apply, Social distancing protocols should be followed, at all times, whilst on site.

Fitted Face Coverings

The following rules and restrictions are in place regarding the wearing of fitted face coverings (ie. face masks);

- A person who is over 12 years of age must wear a fitted face covering over both their nose and mouth while in any indoor area of non-residential premises

Removing fitted face coverings:

- A person may remove a fitted face covering if the person is engaging in strenuous physical activity, except in an indoor area as part of a gym class or dance class
- The person must resume wearing the fitted face covering as soon as practical after the strenuous physical activity ends

Facilities

- Canteen facilities will be available in the CBC (Christian Brother Centre)
- Changerooms will be available. Masks must be worn inside. Players will not be permitted to meet or congregate in changing rooms
- Water bubblers will be operational for filling of water bottles
- Facilities will be cleaned throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices must be adhered to while using all facilities
- First aid will be available on the site.
- St Pius X College has a "No Dogs Policy"

Player Information

We ask that players please:

- Arrive in playing uniform
- Bring and use their own hand sanitiser
- Bring their own clearly marked drink bottle – no sharing permitted, and their own food where possible
- Observe social distancing protocols where possible
- COVID Safe lunch will be provided for ISA Cricket

Upon the completion of the sports fixture we ask that players, staff and spectators adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately. Players are only permitted on site for the game they are playing in.
