This Sunday we observe Social Justice Sunday. The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference Office for Justice, Ecology and Peace has prepared the annual Social Justice Statement, "Cry of the Earth, Cry of the Poor" The Statement reflects on the challenges of climate in our own country through the lens of people's lived experience.
