Our Parish

St Agatha's Parish officially became an independent parish in 1973. Fr Joe O'Hagan was the first parish priest but was then succeeded by Fr George Todd in 1974. In 1976 St Agatha's Primary school opened. The first Church was a wooden church located on High Street and later a brick Church was built on the adjoining site, which was decommissioned and sold; it is still standing today and operates as a restaurant. Our new Church was blessed and opened by Bishop Eric D'Arcy on 13th December 1981. Fr Jim McGuigan was the parish priest. This new Church was made possible by the generous bequest of the late Eddie Donnelly. In 1987, a campus of St Francis Xavier College was established in Cranbourne which was later to become St Peters College in 1994, whilst in 1989, St Therese's primary school was opened.

St. Agatha died in defence of her purity, in Catania, Sicily, where she was born. After Quintanus, the governor of Sicily, tried in vain to force her to consent to sin, she was imprisoned for a month with an evil woman. He then turned from sensuality to cruelty and had her breasts cut off; but that night Agatha was healed by St. Peter. She was then rolled over sharp stones and burning coals, and finally taken to prison where she died while praying. Her name appears in the Roman Canon.
