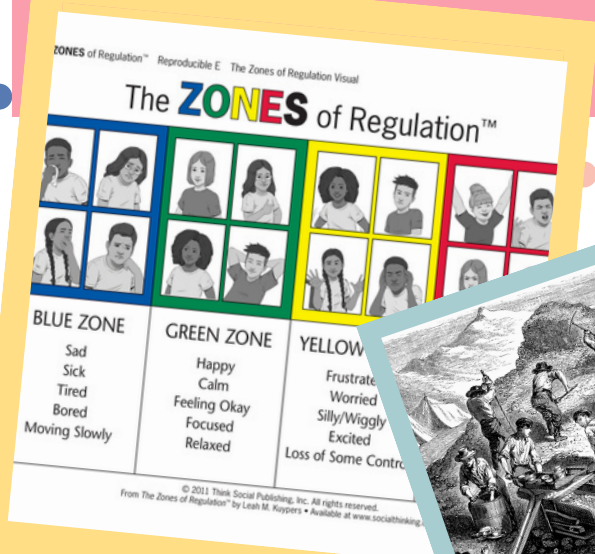
Learning to Learn
