YEAR ONE

Start course work and participate in two Nexus intensives and fortnightly online workshops. Start work in an Education Support role one day a week in Term 2 and then two days a week in Term 3 & 4.



YEAR TWO

Course work continues including a second Nexus intensive. Move to a 0.8 teaching load as a paraprofessional.
