Welcome to Term 3

MSL

This term during \mathbf{M} ultisensory \mathbf{S} tructured \mathbf{L} earning (\mathbf{MSL}) students will be covering a variety of different spelling rules.

- Vowel teams
- Blending and segmenting sounds
- Recognise how high-frequency words have regular and irregular spelling patterns
- Common digraphs
- Exploring syllables types and patterns
- Silent letters, trigraphs, vowel digraphs and common long vowels
- Learning rules for adding suffixes and prefixes in Morphology

The Writing Revolution

This term we are continuing on with our explicit teaching of The Writing Revolution (TWR) lessons focusing on

- Identifying and using subject and object pronouns
- Identifying and using possessive adjectives and pronouns
- Combining 2-3 sentences with conjunctions and pronouns
- Expanding a simple sentence that begins with a fronted adverbial or adverb
- Using Commas in a List
- Identifying and writing the four sentence types of a statement, command, exclamation and question





Mathematics

During Term Three, students will explore:

- Multiplication and division: students will explore key skills and knowledge related to multiplication and division
- Shape: students will explore 2D shapes and their properties that can be described and compared.
- Operations: students will explore all four key operations and develop their knowledge of key mathematical concepts

Topic: Our Blue Planet

This term, we will be focusing on our Earth and the resources it provides as part of our Earth and Space Science unit. Students will explore observable changes in their environment, including changes in the sky and landscape, and how daily and seasonal changes affect everyday life. They will also investigate a range of Earth's resources and elements, such as landscapes, the sun, moon, and solar system.

Religion

In Term three, students will explore The Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11–32), retelling the story through pictures, discussions, and creative activities. They will learn about unconditional love, reflecting on the importance of forgiving, welcoming, and being kind - even when it is hard. Students will be given the opportunity to attend mass as well as liturgies.



Respectful Relationships, Positive Coping and Help Seeking

This term, we will continue our Respectful Relationships lessons and incorporate the Berry Street Education Model into our wellbeing focus. Students will explore how gender norms can influence attitudes, opportunities, and behaviours. They will learn about gender equality, inclusion, human rights, and the importance of relationships that respect people of all genders. Students will also develop their understanding of safe and unsafe behaviours, consent, and their personal rights.
