2E had a go at putting together an exposition into the correct structure.

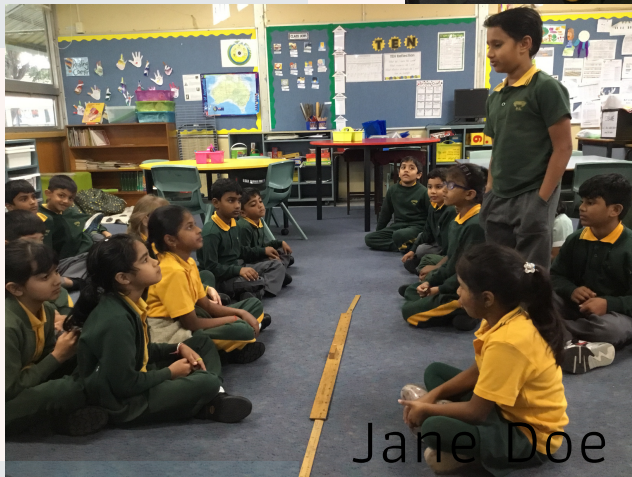
Students completed a class debate, the topic was "Children should not eat fast food".

Children Should Not Eat Fast Food

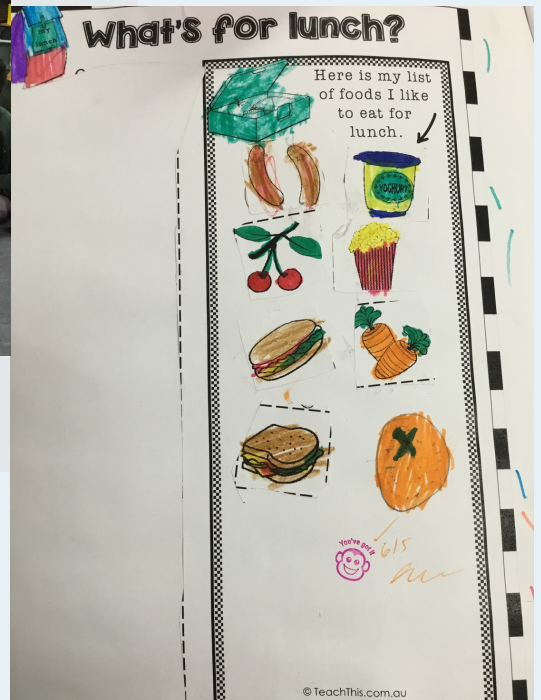
Opening statement
