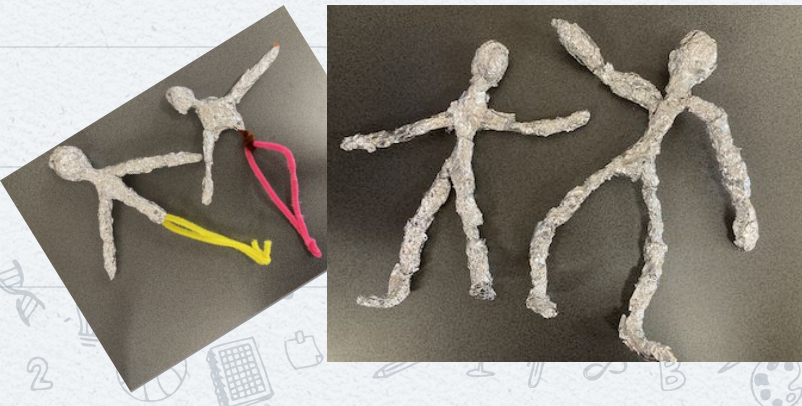


VISUAL ARTS - MIDDLE YEARS

Years 3&4:

Our Year 3 and 4 students have been working hard to complete their own *'tin foil sculptures'*. First, students had to make their own **armature** - which is a supporting framework for sculptures. They used twisted and connected pipecleaners.

Next, students gently moulded aluminium foil strips into a small sphere, which would work as the head and then proceeded to wrap their figure with more foil strips to build up the body.

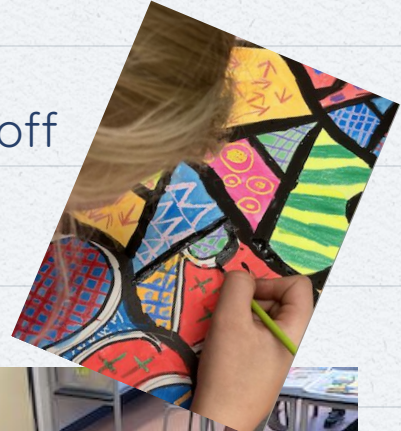
Shadows were traced and coloured, then the foil figures were glued to the backgrounds that had been created in an earlier class. Shadows were to be created in a deeper **value** of the colour paper chosen. *When assembled as a group, they looked absolutely incredible.*

Prior to working on sculptures, Year 3 & 4 students were finishing off paintings that required the use of bright colours, symbols and patterns to represent their connection to family.

The finished works were eye-popping thanks to the contrast of bold black lettering and a fluoro colour scheme.

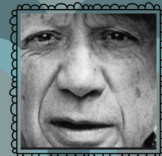
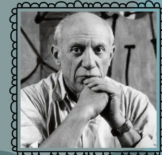

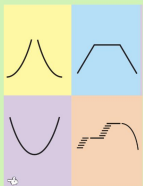

Pitch Patterns



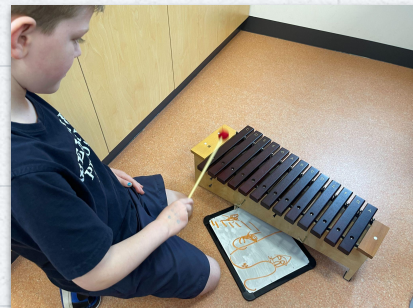
A pitch map is a picture that shows how sounds can move up and down.

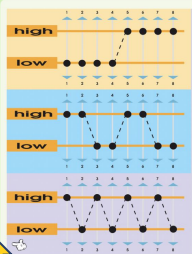

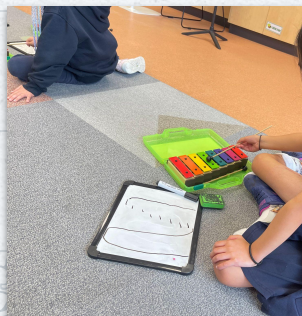
PITCH PATTERNS
