Literacy & Numeracy Update

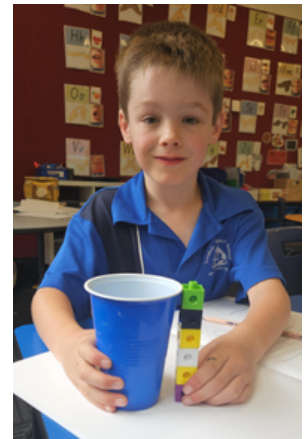
We are excited to share some highlights from our students' learning this week:

Literacy:

Students have explored natural resources found on Earth and learned the importance of Reduce, Reuse, Recycle to minimize waste. They have been practicing writing using the subordinating conjunctions 'if' and 'when' to enhance their sentences.

Numeracy:

Students engaged in problem-solving using measurement, comparing the duration of familiar events and describing activities that occur on different days of the week.



Skill in Focus

Our focus this week has been on recognizing blends in words while decoding. Blends are formed when two consonant sounds come together, such as:

- **st** in "stop"
- **dr** in "drift"
- **cl** in "clap"
