

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Uniform Policy

Clayfield College is proud of its uniform. The uniform instils a sense of personal pride in the student cohort and is a strong representation of the College and its unity. Each student is a representative of Clayfield College when they are in uniform and they are expected to wear the uniform as per outlined in the Uniform Policy.

Uniform standards must be maintained. The College expects parents and carers to support the school by ensuring that the uniform is worn with pride and respect at all times.

Students who do not comply with the Uniform Policy will be spoken to by the Pastoral Care Team and, if necessary, parents and carers will be advised of the need for the uniform to be corrected.

Students may be issued with an infringement notice for not wearing the uniform correctly.

The College appreciates the support of parents and carers in upholding our Uniform Policy, and to ensuring our students maintain the highest standards of appearance.

All uniforms must be clearly named.

Inclusivity

Students have the right to dress in a manner consistent with their gender identity and expression.

Gender diverse students are therefore able to consult with our Deputy Principals about their uniform requirements based on their individual needs and circumstances.

Which Uniform on which day?

The Formal Winter uniform must always be worn for special events such as Speech Night and other events as notified by the Principal, Dr Andrew Cousins.

Primary Years:

Pre-Prep

Pre-Prep students wear their polo shirt and shorts each day.

Primary Years:

Prep to Year 6

School uniform or HPE uniform to be worn on child's nominated HPE days.

Secondary Years:

Years 7 to 12

Monday to Friday - Summer or Winter School uniform. Students are required to change into their HPE uniform before their HPE class and change back into their school uniform after class.

Students are not permitted to travel outside of the College in their HPE uniform unless special permission is given.

Student Appearance

Hair must be tidy and in a conservative style, appropriate for the uniform. Long hair must be tied up if touching the collar and fastened back away from the face. College ribbons and green clips or scrunchies are acceptable for girls, elastic for boys.

Make-up, including false eyelashes, mascara and tanning products, must not be worn. Nail polish and acrylic nails are not acceptable. Chewing gum is not permitted.

The only articles of jewellery that are permitted to be worn with the College uniform are earrings for pierced ears, and watches. Exceptions are permitted for cultural pieces of jewellery; however, these must not be visible. Only matching plain small studs or sleepers, gold, silver or pearl, may be worn - one in each ear lobe in the lower hole. Studs or sleepers with stones or with twisting or thickening are not acceptable. Tongue studs and visible body piercing are not allowed. Body decoration of any kind is not allowed.

Uniform Transition

We are excited to be transitioning to a new Summer and Winter school uniform and HPE uniform, as outlined in this Uniform Policy. The transition period concludes at the end of the 2025 school year.

Track Jacket and Track Pants

Students may wear the College Track Jacket and Track Pants over their uniform during cold weather.

Shoes

Brown sandals (warmer months)

Sneakers (cooler months)

Socks

Plain white ankle socks must be worn (cooler months).

Hat

Bucket hat worn outdoors and to and from school.



Primary Years: Prep to Year 6

Girls - School Uniform

Shoes

Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be no greater than 2-2.5 centimetres. Students may wear black Velcro leather shoes.

Hemline

Uniform hemline should cover the kneecap, except for the skort (Prep - Year 6).

Badges

House badge must be worn on the left collar of the blouse and dress.

Hat

The Panama hat must be worn to and from school. The Bucket hat must be worn when outdoors during the school day.



Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

Blouse

Pinstripe blouse must be tucked into skort.

Skort

Navy pleated skort with internal shorts.

Dress

Pinstripe pleated dress with zipper pocket.

Socks

Plain white ankle socks must be worn with the skort or dress. They should be turned down, short sports socks/invisible socks are not permitted.

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

Blouse

Pinstripe blouse must be tucked into skort.

Skort

Navy pleated skort with internal shorts.

Dress

Pinstripe pleated dress with zipper pocket.

Knitted Wear

The knitted jumper, or knitted vest may be worn as part of the Winter uniform.

Socks

Navy knee high socks or navy tights must be worn with the dress or skort. Only tights and socks purchased through the Uniform Shop will be acceptable.

Primary Years: Prep to Year 6

Boys - School Uniform

Shoes

Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be no greater than 2-2.5 centimetres. Students may wear black Velcro leather shoes.

Hemline

Shorts should sit on the knee.

Badges

House badge must be worn on the pocket hem of the shirt.

Hat

The Boater hat must be worn to and from school. The Bucket hat must be worn when outdoors during the school day.



Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

Shirt

Green striped shirt must be tucked into shorts.

Navy shorts

Socks

Navy striped crew socks purchased through the Uniform Shop.

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

Shirt

Green striped shirt must be tucked into shorts.

Bottoms

Navy shorts

Optional Item

Navy trousers with the school belt (optional for Year 6 only).

Knitted Wear

The knitted jumper, or knitted vest may be worn as part of the Winter uniform.

Socks

Navy striped crew socks or navy knee-high socks purchased through the Uniform Shop.

Secondary Years: Years 7 to 12

Girls - Formal Uniform worn at special events.

Blazer

The blazer is compulsory.

Blouse with Tie

The long sleeved white Winter shirt must be tucked in and worn with the Winter tie.

Skirt

Navy skirt should cover the kneecap.

Tights

Navy tights must be worn.

Hat

Bottle green felt hat

Shoes

Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be no greater than 2-2.5 centimetres.

Badges

School badge and House badge must be placed on the blazer lapel; students' left hand side.



Secondary Years: Years 7 to 12

Girls - School Uniform worn everyday including to and from School.

Summer (Term 1 and 4)

Blouse with Tie

The short sleeved Summer shirt must be tucked in and always be worn with the Summer tie.

Plain white socks purchased from the Uniform Shop. Short sports socks/invisible socks are not permitted.

Hat

The Panama hat worn to and from school and when outside.

Shoes

Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be no greater than 2-2.5 centimetres.

Badges

School badge must be placed on the bottom of the tie. House badge should be placed on collar of blouse.

Winter (Term 2 and 3)

Blazer

The school blazer must be worn to and from school.

Blouse with Tie

The long sleeved white Winter shirt must be tucked in and worn with the Winter tie.

Skirt

Navy skirt should cover the kneecap.

Optional Items

Navy pants

Knitted wear may be worn but must be covered with a blazer outside of the College.

Tights/Socks

Navy tights or navy ankle socks (warmer weather) purchased through the Uniform Shop.

Hat

Bottle green felt hat worn to and from school and when outside.

Shoes

Shoes must be polished and be plain black leather with black laces - no coloured laces, stitching or metal eyelets. Suede shoes or shoes with suede trim are not permitted. Heels must be no greater than 2-2.5 centimetres.

Badges

School badge and House badge must be placed on the blazer lapel; students' left hand side.

Secondary Years: Years 7 to 12

Boys - Formal Uniform worn at special events.

Blazer

The blazer is compulsory.

Shirt with Tie

The long sleeved white Winter shirt must be tucked in and worn with the school tie.

School Shirt with Tie

The short sleeved Summer shirt must be tucked in and worn with the school tie.

Navy Shorts with Black Belt

Navy shorts with the school belt. Shorts should sit on the knee.

Socks

Navy striped crew socks purchased through the Uniform Shop.

Hat

Navy felt hat worn to and from school and when outside.

Badges

School badge must be placed on the bottom of the tie. House badge should be placed on the pocket hem of the school shirt.

Winter (Term 2 and 3)

Blazer

The blazer must be worn to and from school.

Shirt with Tie

The long sleeved white Winter shirt must be tucked in and worn with the school tie.

Navy Trousers with Black Belt

Navy trousers with the school belt.

Socks

Navy crew striped socks purchased through the Uniform Shop.

Hat

Navy felt school hat worn to and from school and when outside.

Badges

School badge and House badge must be placed on the blazer lapel; students' left hand side.

Optional

Knitted wear may be worn during Winter, but must be covered by the blazer outside of the College.

HPE Uniform: Prep to Year 12

Worn for HPE lessons.

Shirt

Polo shirt or long-sleeve shirt

Bottoms

Navy shorts or skorts

Bike Pants

Girls may choose to wear College bike pants under their shorts, and if so, these are the only acceptable bike pants. Bike pants are not to be worn without shorts over the top.

Spray Jacket and Track Pants

Students are allowed to wear the College jacket and pants over their HPE uniform during cold weather.

Hat

Sports Cap or Bucket Hat must be worn during outdoor activities.



All orders placed through the portal can be collected from the Uniform Shop the next trading day after the order is placed; collection is dependent on the day as the shop only trades Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

All orders will need to be processed and then available for collection by approximately 9:00am on the next opening day unless any unforeseen circumstances arise. All orders must be collected from the Uniform Shop.
