RMIT's *I Belong* programs give students from our Schools Network Access Program (SNAP) partner schools the chance to explore our campuses and discover what life as a university student is all about.

We invite Year 11 and 12 students who are interested in a career in design to visit RMIT's City campus and discover tools and strategies to support preparation for and transition to tertiary education.

Now in its tenth year, *Ready Set Design* is a series of three workshops focused on careers and tertiary programs in design.

Workshops are held during the April, June and September school holidays. We recommend that students attend all three sessions to get the most out of *Ready Set Design*.

For 2021, we are also offering an additional digital session for each event, to extend the range of design disciplines explored.
