As part of the Orange NAIDOC Week 2023 Celebrations the Orange NAIDOC Week Committee are seeking nominations from School Staff, Teachers and Aboriginal Education Workers for Indigenous students that have attained achievements in the last 12 months. This may be an achievement based on effort and we encourage nominations for students that don't necessarily get acknowledged regularly.

We are looking for students that, no matter how big or small the achievement may be, has been identified as making an improvement. Some examples are a student has missed less days of school, improved in a particular topic or subject, has received less/no detentions, improved reading level or has lent a hand to another student.

You can nominate as many students as you wish. All nominated students will be acknowledged. Each school will be allocated 2 awards, 1 in each of the following age groups:

Primary Schools

Kindergarten – Year 2

Year 3 – Year 6

High Schools

Year 7 – Year 9

Year 10 – Year 11

Nominations will be voted on by a group of Elders.

NOTE: Year 12 students are not able to be nominated as they will all receive a Completion of Year 12 Acknowledgement gift.
