It is a time for self-discovery and an opportunity to think about your strengths and find new ones.

It is a unique opportunity for you to learn more about your strengths and abilities, while exploring potential career options - giving you the confidence to start taking control of your future.

The My Career Insights Journey

PHASE 1: DISCOVER

You will begin by completing a series of online questions on the Morrisby website. These questions have been designed to help you learn more about yourself and your:

values

preferences

skills

strengths

These personal insights help open-up a variety of possible career pathways, specifically tailored to who you are.

PHASE 2: DEVELOP

Once you have completed your Morrisby profile, you'll be given an opportunity to discuss your results with a Morrisby trained Careers Consultant.

This discussion may be face-to-face at school or through a video conference.

Your results will remain locked until this discussion.

This information kit will guide you through Phase 1. Further information about Phase 2 will be provided to you by your school.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE GETTING STARTED
