APPEA Oil & Gas Industry Engineering Scholarship

The Tony Noon Scholarship is open to all Australian residents who are already undertaking a degree, with an aim to one-day work in the petroleum industry. Current Year 12 students are encouraged to flag this scholarship and apply in the August of the year relevant to them. Applicants must be enrolled in honours, Masters, or PhD programs at an Australian university and may come from a range of disciplines, including, for example, geology, safety, engineering, economics, law, or environmental management. The scholarship is a once-off grant of \$3,000.

Outstanding and Excellent Achiever Scholarships

Valued over \$10,000, the **AMC Outstanding Achiever Scholarships** are awarded annually to students who have achieved an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) 96+, qualify for a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP), and who are commencing their first year of study in any undergraduate level degree program offered by the National Centre for Maritime Engineering & Hydrodynamics (NCMEH) or the National Centre for Ports & Shipping (NCPS) - maritime and logistics management or maritime engineering.

Valued over \$8,000 the **AMC Excellent Achiever Scholarships** are awarded annually to students who have achieved Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) between 90 - 95, who qualify for a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP), and who are commencing their first year of study in any undergraduate level degree program offered by the National Centre for Maritime Engineering & Hydrodynamics (NCMEH) or the National Centre for Ports & Shipping (NCPS) - maritime and logistics management or maritime engineering.

Women in Maritime Engineering Scholarship

To increase female participation in maritime engineering programs, AMC is offering scholarships to young women. The scholarship will cover 75% of the first year of the oncampus accommodation costs in a single room at one of the Halls of Residence in Launceston. On offer to all female CSP students applying for **maritime engineering** programs with specialisations in naval architecture, ocean engineering or marine and offshore engineering, who attain an ATAR of between 70.00 and 89.00, and meet prerequisite entry requirements.

Australian Excellence Scholarship

Each year ANU offers an award known as the Australian Excellence Scholarship to acknowledge the achievement and provide financial assistance and support to the top 3 domestic students' applying directly to the University for admission who achieve the

highest ANU selection rank or ATAR in each Australian state and territory. Valued at \$12,500 per annum for up to five years. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

National University Scholarship

Awarded to eligible CSP students who have achieved an ATAR of 99.90 and above, across all faculties. No application is required. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Scholarship valued at \$12,500 per year, for a maximum of five years.

Excellence Scholarships for International Students

Valued at \$5000 in the first year followed by 10% discount of tuition fees for years of study thereafter. For international students who have achieved at an excellent level in their final years of schooling, demonstrated by excellent results in their secondary studies qualification.

College of Business & Economics Terrell Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 per annum for 1 year or \$5000 per student if two scholarships are awarded, and open to CSP <u>and</u> International students entering a Bachelor of Economics or Bachelor of Finance or a double degree with one of the programs offered by the College. All students anticipating an ATAR of 90 and a demonstrated high Mathematics achievement, are encouraged to apply.

College of Business & Economics International Undergraduate Scholarship

The Scholarships will cover the full (100%) International student tuition fee cost each year, for the minimum standard full-time duration of the scholars' chosen undergraduate program, excluding an Honours Year. The scholarship is available to students completing a single or combined degree.

Dennis Griffin National Piano Undergraduate Scholarships

Applicants must have received an offer by the School of Music in the piano and composition area of the School. No application required as all new undergraduate students – CSP <u>and</u> International – will be automatically considered. Students must demonstrate outstanding musical ability and accomplishment, which will be assessed at audition Scholarship valued at \$5,000 per annum over three years.

College of Business & Economics National Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 per annum and awarded to CSP students with a minimum ATAR of 95.00 and who have made an application to ANU for one of the qualifying business courses to ANU. All eligible students will be automatically considered, and no application is required.

Coral Bell Scholarship

The Coral Bell Scholarship is awarded for full-time study in the Bachelor of International Security Studies Program. The scholarship aims to honour the legacy of Coral Bell by providing the means for a high achieving student to study in the Bell School's Bachelor of International Security Studies (BINSS) degree. The scholarship will cover the tuition fees for the Bachelor of International Security Studies degree and provide a \$5000 stipend per annum. Awarded to both CSP <u>and</u> International students who attain a minimum ATAR of 95.00 and have made an application to ANU for the Bachelor of Actuarial Studies, Bachelor of Finance, or Bachelor of Statistics (combined degrees are accepted). No application necessary as all eligible students considered automatically. Scholarship valued at \$5,000 – a once-off payment.

Research School of Finance, Actuarial Studies & Statistics Bachelor of Finance, Economics & Statistics (Honours) Scholarship

Awarded to CSP students with a minimum ATAR of 99.00 and entering the Bachelor of Finance, Economics, and Statistics (Honours). No application necessary as all eligible students considered automatically. Scholarship valued at \$10,000 – paid in two instalments.

College of Engineering & Computer Science Advanced Computer Research & Development Female Excellence Scholarship

Female CSP students who have applied for the Bachelor of Advanced Computing (Research & Development) (Honours), and expect a minimum ATAR 99.00, are eligible to apply for this scholarship, valued at \$7,500 per annum paid over 1 year

College of Engineering & Computer Science Engineering Research & Development Female Excellence Scholarship

Female CSP students who have applied for the Bachelor of Engineering (Research & Development) (Honours), and expect a minimum ATAR 99.00, are eligible to apply for this scholarship, valued at \$5,000 per annum.

College of Engineering & Computer Science Research & Development Excellence Scholarship

CSP students must have an ATAR of 99.00 and have applied for admission and will enrol into a single or Flexible Double Degree program of Bachelor of Engineering (R&D) (Honours) or Bachelor of Advanced Computing (R&D) (Honours) offered by the College. Students must have made an application through UAC and apply for the scholarship. Scholarship valued at \$7,500 for students outside of the ACT.

College of Engineering and Computer Science Female Excellence Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships awarded to female CSP students who achieve an ATAR of 93.00 and who are enrolling in Undergraduate programs offered by the College of Engineering and Computer Science. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered. Scholarship valued at \$5,000.

Bond University

Bond University offers an extensive scholarship program, with values ranging from 25% scholarships to 100% scholarships. The scholarships listed below are open to both local <u>and</u> International students. Some of the scholarships on offer include:

Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarships

This 100% scholarship is available to all Year 12 students with an ATAR above 96.00; with demonstrated strong leadership skills, and extensive involvement in extra-curricular activities. Open to all undergraduate degrees excluding the Bond Medical Program. Applications for this scholarship close 1 August 2019.

Excellence Scholarships

Excellence Scholarships are available in two categories: Excellence Scholarship and Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarship

Awarded to Year 12 CSP and International students with an ATAR of over 92.00, demonstrating exceptional potential, strong leadership skills and extensive involvement in extra-curricular activities and community involvement.

Excellence Scholarships cover up to 50% tuition for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program).

Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships cover up to 50% tuition for a Bachelor of Laws or approved combined undergraduate degree including a Bachelor of Laws.

Leadership Scholarship

The Bond University Leadership Scholarship aims to recognise current Year 12 students who have outstanding leadership experience and community involvement with a partialfee tuition remission scholarship. Eligibility is based on applicants meeting a minimum academic requirement as well as providing evidence of outstanding leadership and community achievements. Open to CSP and International student who are predicted to achieve an ATAR of 84 and valued at up to 25% tuition for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program).

Transformer Scholarship

The <u>Transformer</u> is a co-curricular program offering at Bond designed to enable students to innovatively tackle real-world problems that matter. It is a program that attracts motivated, self-directed individuals who want to work in collaborative, interdisciplinary teams on challenging projects that typically span multiple semesters. Transformer Scholarships are awarded annually to students beginning their Bachelor's degree or Master's degree study at Bond University in the following year, January semester.

Transformer Scholarships offer up to 50% tuition remission for any single undergraduate Bachelor's degree or postgraduate Master's degree program (excluding the Bond Medical Program) and are awarded to students who have high potential to affect real change through participation in the Transformer program.

Riewoldt Family AFL Excellence Scholarship

As a proud partner of AFL Queensland, Bond University is offering two Riewoldt Family AFL Excellence Scholarships for CSP students commencing university in January 2020. Offered in partnership with the Riewoldt Family, these unique full tuition scholarships for entry into any course excluding the Bond Medical Program, will provide an opportunity for one male and one female to enhance their footballing career whilst also gaining a first class educational experience at Bond University. The scholarship also includes free accommodation for the first year should the scholar wish to live in a University residence.

John Eales Rugby Excellence

Awarded to a Year 12 student Australian student eligible to represent Australian Rugby, meets the academic requirements for the course selected, has experience playing rugby at a high level, and can demonstrate strong leadership skills and community involvement. The scholarship covers 100% tuition fees any single diploma program, single undergraduate degree, single postgraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program), as well as a \$10,000 bursary in each year of study.

Indigenous Scholarships

These scholarships are valued up to 50% of tuition fees for any single undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program) and are awarded to Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander students who have demonstrated extracurricular involvement, leadership potential and academic achievements.

Georgina Hope Rinehart Swimming Excellence Scholarship

The Georgina Hope Rinehart Excellence Scholarship is targeted at high performance swimming scholars offering a 100% scholarship plus \$21,000 living expenses for students to compete at an elite level while gaining an education at Bond University. This scholarship is open to students who are eligible to compete for Australia; are swimming at a very high level for their school or club; have a high academic record, and who possess leadership qualities. Available to all Australian students applying for a single undergraduate degree, postgraduate degree, or diploma at Bond University (excluding the Bond Medical Program).

ADCO Sports Excellence Scholarship

The ADCO Sports Excellence Scholarship celebrates this by awarding sporting scholarships to outstanding sports men and women from around Australia with the chance to help fund their tertiary studies. All students who apply for study at the University of Tasmania will be automatically considered for this scholarship based on their ATAR.

Dean's Merit Scholarships

Open to CSP <u>and</u> International students, these scholarships are available to school leavers who demonstrate academic excellence and are valued at \$10,000 per year for up to five years of study in any course plus a once-off \$5,000 payment for students eligible to undertake a semester of overseas exchange at one of the University's partner institutions. This scholarship includes a package of support to help with the costs of University study. Each scholarship will consist of a cash incentive, optional overseas study experience, on-campus employment opportunity, and a guaranteed place in oncampus accommodation. All students who apply for study at the University of Tasmania will be automatically considered for this scholarship based on their ATAR.

Global Leaders Scholarships

These scholarships are available to commencing students who demonstrate strong leadership qualities and community-based involvement. These scholarships are valued at \$5,000 per year for up to five years, and includes a cash incentive, optional overseas study experience (valued at \$5,000), an involvement in student leadership activities and a guaranteed place in on-campus accommodation. Selection for this scholarship will be based on the student's demonstration of leadership qualities, a recommendation from a school principal, employer, community or industry group, and evidence of financial need. ❖ Don Kay Tasmania University Scholarship in Music

The scholarship will provide course fees for one year and is available to a CSP student commencing study at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music. Preference may be given to students intending to study piano and/or composition. As applicants will be assessed on the quality of their <u>online application</u>, all questions should be answered in full.

Pharmacy Undergraduate Scholarship

Open to highly motivated students hoping to study for a career in Pharmacy. Students who have the required pre-requisites and ATAR will be eligible to apply for and receive \$3,000 per year up to four years. All applicants will be assessed on the quality of their online application, all questions should be answered in full. Students must demonstrate through their application their commitment to pharmacy as a career. The successful applicant may be asked to assist in marketing for the Division.

Agriculture and Food Systems Scholarship

Valued at \$4,000 per year over four years, this scholarship is available to students who achieve an ATAR of 97 or greater and who are commencing study in the Bachelor of Agricultural Science or the Bachelor of Applied Science (Agriculture and Business). On graduation too, the Tasmanian Institute of Agriculture (TIA) offers research opportunities in many areas which have practical benefit for the state and nation. As applicants will be assessed on the quality of their <u>online application</u>, all questions should be answered in full.

Applications for most awards open early August and close strictly on 31 October 2019. Scholarship offers are made from December 2019 onwards. University of Technology – Sydney

Some merit scholarships include -

Vice-Chancellor's Outstanding Achievement Scholarship

Valued at \$12,500 per year, these scholarships are on offer to CSP students who attain an ATAR of 95.00 or above and have applied to study a course at UTS through UAC. These scholarships are awarded automatically following the release of ATAR results in December, although you must be enrolling as a local student and have a University of Technology Sydney course preference on your UAC application to be eligible. However, students may choose to make an <u>online application</u> in mid-September. By completing this application, you will be considered for all UTS Elite School Leaver scholarships subject to eligibility. Other selection criteria include motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, as demonstrated in the <u>online scholarship application</u> or as determined by UTS, and initiative in personal life, as demonstrated in the scholarship application or as determined by UTS.

Bachelor of Accounting Scholarship

The Bachelor of Accounting is a co-operative education program, being a three-way partnership between the sponsor organisations, UTS and the students. Co-operative programs are awarded to CSP students with a good academic record (ATAR 90.00 + but not essential), demonstrated leadership potential, and a genuine interest in accounting. Applicants will also have to demonstrate personal attributes needed to succeed both as a student and in a business career - communication skills, inter-personal skills, teamworking skills, problem-solving skills, enthusiasm, and dedication. All CSP students in the Bachelor of Accounting co-operative program receive a generous income tax-exempt scholarship per year for 3 years, valued at over \$51,500. In addition, all students who are recruited by a sponsor organisation in their final year of study will receive a Recruitment Incentive bonus for the second half of the year. In addition to the scholarship payments above, any student who has to move home in order to join the course in Sydney will receive a Relocation Allowance. Students will also need to submit an online application and selection for an interview is based on the record of achievements set out in the written Application Form. Business Dean's Scholarship

Valued at \$30,000 over three years, this scholarship is awarded to a top CSP student who attains the highest ranked ATAR, and who applies to undertake a UTS Bachelor of Business degree. Selection is based on academic excellence at Year 12 level; demonstrated initiative in personal and professional life and motivation to succeed in the UTS Bachelor of Business degree. These scholarships are awarded automatically following the release of ATAR results in December, although you must be enrolling as a local student and have a University of Technology Sydney course preference on your UAC application to be eligible. However, students may choose to make an online application

in mid-September 2019. By completing this application, you will be considered for all UTS Elite School Leaver scholarships subject to eligibility. Other selection criteria include motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, as demonstrated in the online-scholarship application or as determined by UTS, and initiative in personal life, as demonstrated in the scholarship application or as determined by UTS.

❖ Bachelor of Information Technology Co-operative Scholarship Program

he Bachelor of Information Technology is a cooperative education program between the University and sponsoring organisations. The co-operative program prepares CSP students for an exciting career in IT management. Successful applicants receive a scholarship of \$49,500 over three years. Co-operative programs are awarded to students with a good academic record, demonstrated leadership potential, and a genuine interest in IT. Students need to meet the prerequisite subjects, attain an ATAR of 85.00 - 99.00+, submit the online UTS BIT application form by 8 September 2019 and short-listed students will be invited to attend an interview on 3 October 2019 - https://www.uts.edu.au/about/faculty-engineering-and-information-technology/bachelor-information-technology-co-operative/how-to-apply/apply

Law Dean's Scholarship

To attract top achieving high school students to the UTS Law undergraduate degrees and support them financially during their first year of study. This scholarship, which offers a once-off amount of \$10,000, is awarded to CSP students who attain an ATAR of 98.00 and above. These scholarships are awarded automatically following the release of ATAR results in December, although you must be enrolling as a local student and have a University of Technology Sydney course preference on your UAC application to be eligible. However, students may choose to make an <u>online application</u> in mid-September 2019. By completing this application, you will be considered for all UTS Elite School Leaver scholarships subject to eligibility. Other selection criteria include motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, as demonstrated in the <u>online scholarship</u> <u>application</u> or as determined by UTS, and initiative in personal life, as demonstrated in the scholarship application or as determined by UTS.

UTS Science International Undergraduate Scholarship for Excellence

Valued at \$5,000, this scholarship is available to any eligible International student commencing a Faculty of Science full-time undergraduate degree. All eligible students are considered and academic merit in the academic qualification used as basis of admission into the selected UTS Bachelor degree program is the sole basis for awarding this scholarship. There is not a separate scholarship application form.

Science Dean's Scholarship

CSP students attaining an ATAR of 99.00 and above are eligible to apply for this scholarship valued at \$10,000. These scholarships are awarded automatically following the release of ATAR results in December, although you must be enrolling as a local student and have a University of Technology Sydney course preference on your UAC application to be eligible. However, students may choose to make an <u>online application</u> in mid-September 2019. By completing this application, you will be considered for all UTS Elite School Leaver scholarships subject to eligibility. Other selection criteria include motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, as demonstrated in the <u>online</u>

<u>scholarship application</u> or as determined by UTS, and initiative in personal life, as demonstrated in the scholarship application or as determined by UTS.

Science High Achievers Scholarship

CSP students attaining an ATAR of 95.00 and above and applying for a science program at UTS are eligible to apply for this scholarship, valued at \$2,000 per year over three years. Selecting one of the eligible UTS Science courses – visit https://www.uts.edu.au/scholarship/uts-science-high-achievers-scholarship – as their first UAC preference will be highly regarded, and students must also make an online application for the scholarship Applicants will need to demonstrate their motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, and demonstrate initiative in personal life.

Engineering and Information Technology Dean's Scholarship

Valued at \$20,000 and paid over two years, the Engineering and Information Technology Dean's Scholarship is on academic merit. Any prospective CSP students who attain an ATAR (95.00 and above) and have applied to undertake any UTS Engineering and Information Technology undergraduate degree will be eligible for this scholarship. These scholarships are awarded automatically following the release of ATAR results in December, although you must be enrolling as a local student and have a University of Technology Sydney course preference on your UAC application to be eligible. However, students may choose to make an online application in mid-September 2019 - Elite School Leaver Scholarship Application Form. By completing this application, you will be considered for all UTS Elite School Leaver scholarships subject to eligibility. Other selection criteria include motivation to succeed in the chosen degree program, as demonstrated in the online scholarship application or as determined by UTS, and initiative in personal life, as demonstrated in the scholarship application or as determined by UTS.

Undergraduate Full Tuition Scholarships for International Students

The International Undergraduate Full Tuition Scholarship was established to support high achieving commencing International students enrolling in an undergraduate program at UTS in Sydney. UTS will pay successful recipients the UTS tuition fees for the approved Bachelor degree course for the duration of the scholarship, which is the standard number of sessions required for completion of the chosen undergraduate course based on full-time study load. Students must complete an <u>online application form</u> when applications open in November 2019.

Students should also check whether the scholarships they are applying for are <u>deferrable</u> or not.

It is also advantageous to visit the university websites regularly as they are frequently updated, and detail numerous other scholarships (access & equity scholarships, and accommodation scholarships) not referred to in this resource.

Students should also note that not every tertiary institution is listed here. It is imperative that students are methodical in researching the websites of the institutions they are applying to themselves.

Where possible, reference has been made as to whether the scholarship is available to Commonwealth Supported Students (CSP) – referring to Australian citizens, some New Zealand citizens, and residents on Permanent Humanitarian Visas only – or whether it is open to International students too.

Students should double-check their eligibility themselves.
