Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As we prepare for the upcoming academic year, we wish to inform you of the tuition fees for 2026. We remain committed to providing high-quality education within a nurturing Christian environment, and we deeply value your continued partnership in this journey.

# **Tuition Fees for 2026**

The tuition fees for 2026 have been reviewed in light of rising operational costs, our commitment to maintaining excellent educational standards, and our desire to remain an affordable school.

In response to parent feedback, we have continued to simplify our fee structure. In 2025, we incorporated most school camps and excursions into the tuition fee. For 2026, we are extending this further:

- All compulsory school camps and excursions, including the Year 9 Camp program, are now included in the tuition fee.
- Subject fees for Years 9–12, previously charged separately, are also now incorporated into the tuition fee.

# **College Provided Devices**

We continue to roll out College-provided devices to support student learning. From 2026, the College will supply laptop devices to students in Years 7 and 8. Our long-term intention is to provide a College-owned device in Year 7 that will meet students' needs through to Year 10. As students mature and develop individual preferences, they may then transition to a BYOD model in their senior years. In 2026, students in Years 9-12 will continue to bring their own laptop device.

## **New Partnership with Compassion Australia**

We are excited to announce a new partnership with Compassion Australia, launching a whole-of-school service-learning model. This initiative will help students grow year by year in empathy, global awareness, servant leadership, and biblical justice. It integrates spiritual formation, practical experiences, and real relationships, both locally and globally.

As part of this partnership, an optional, opt-out donation will be included with tuition fees. This donation goes directly to Compassion Australia to support the school partnership program and their mission of releasing children from poverty in Jesus' name. Each year group will be connected with a group of sponsor children, and students will engage in writing and receiving letters, learning about their lives and the impact of Compassion's work.

## 2026 Annual Tuition Fees

• Kindergarten – Year 6: \$4,733

• Years 7 – 8: \$6,824

• Years 9 – 12: \$8,453

If your family is not intending to continue at the College in 2026, please note that a minimum of one term's notice is required. For practical purposes, any notice of withdrawal received before 7 November 2025 will be considered sufficient for Term 1, 2026.
