


Day one of isolation began on Monday 23rd March 2020

I was very sad because they cancelled all my sports. I was lucky we have a table tennis table and to overcome the early days of boredom I would play my mum and dad.




Campfire dinner 7/4/2020


Pop turns 75 - 4/5/2020
