Each year, the world's 2.2 billion Christians are invited to give thanks for creation, to pray and do what we can to care for our planet Earth and our most vulnerable people, creatures and plants. The Season of Creation extends from 1st September, the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, to 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Feast of St Francis of Assisi. We are lucky in the Southern Hemisphere, where this season coincides with Spring.

The 2023 theme takes up the cry of the prophets to 'Let Justice and Peace Flow'. The symbol of this year's Season is 'A Mighty River'. We are called to join the river of justice and peace, to take up climate and ecological justice, and to speak out with and for communities most impacted by climate injustice and the loss of biodiversity.

Beautiful quilts made by one of our parishioners, showing the symbol of this year's Season of Creation, have been placed before the lecterns in our churches.
